**Nature of bill:** Extension of temporary duty suspension through December 31, 2011.

Trichloroacetaldehyde (CAS No. 75-87-6) (provided for in subheading 2913.00.50).

**Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:**

The subject product, a synthetic organic chemical, is an intermediate that is used to make Trichlorofon, which is formulated into Dylox, a grub control agent for professional and consumer use. The product is imported from India.<sup>4</sup>

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## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on  
Trichloroacetaldehyde.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRICHLOROACETALDEHYDE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.10.31 of the Har-  
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended  
6 by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
8 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
9 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
10 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
