To extend the temporary suspension of duty on esters and sodium esters of parahydroxybenzoic acid.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. ESTERS AND SODIUM ESTERS OF 4 PARAHYDROXYBENZOIC ACID.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.75 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
esters and sodium esters of parahydroxybenzoic acid) is
amended by striking "12/31/2009" and inserting "12/31/
2011".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 the date of the enactment of this Act.
