MEMORANDUM ON PROPOSED TARIFF LEGISLATION of the 110th Congress ¹

Nature of bill: Temporary duty suspension through December 31, 2011.

Retroactive effect: None.

Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):

Cast stainless steel single-piece exhaust gas manifolds, suitable for use solely or principally with spark-ignition internal combustion engines and certified by the importer as capable of withstanding exhaust gas temperatures of 900 degrees C or higher (provided for in subheading 8409.91.50).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

These exhaust gas manifolds are made of cast stainless steel and are designed to withstand exhaust gas temperatures of 900 degrees Celsius or higher. Exhaust gas manifolds collect the exhaust gas from each of the cylinders of a spark-ignition internal combustion engine and route the gas to an exhaust catalyst and muffler and tailpipe system. The subject exhaust gas manifolds are cast as a single piece. Increasingly, environmental regulations have resulted in increased use of high performance engines that produce higher exhaust gas temperatures. Exhaust gas manifolds for engines with lower exhaust gas temperatures may be made of aluminum, cast iron, or steel tubing. The subject exhaust gas manifolds will be imported from Japan. Of the \$1.5 billion in dutiable U.S. imports under HTS subheading 8409.91.50 (a broader category than is covered by the bill), Japan accounted for \$979 million in shipments.
