

The Commission staff notes that there should be a single prime symbol after the second N, and “dimethylacetoacetamide” should not be capitalized, as shown on page 1 of this report.

However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain mixtures of N,N-Dimethylacetoacetamide.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MIXTURES OF N,N-**  
4 **DIMETHYLACETOACETAMIDE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Mixtures of N,N-Dimethylacetamide (CAS No. 2044-64-6) with an additive that stabilizes color and diluted in water with a calculated assay of not less than 93% and not more than 99% (provided for in subheading 2924.19.11) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.
