Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Draft Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5345-56A, *Airport Lighting Control and Monitoring System*, is being re-circulated to interested industry associations to obtain comments and recommendations of actions to be taken. Please review this draft and submit comments as appropriate. Additionally, please provide justification for all comments regarding oppositions and recommended modifications. The final document may be revised as a result of comments received and further review by the Office of Airport Safety and Standards.

This AC specifies the requirements for light fixtures for use on airport runways and taxiways. Concurrence with the enclosure is requested. Comments received prior to June 1, 2009, will be considered for inclusion in the advisory circular. Concurrence with the enclosure is requested.
