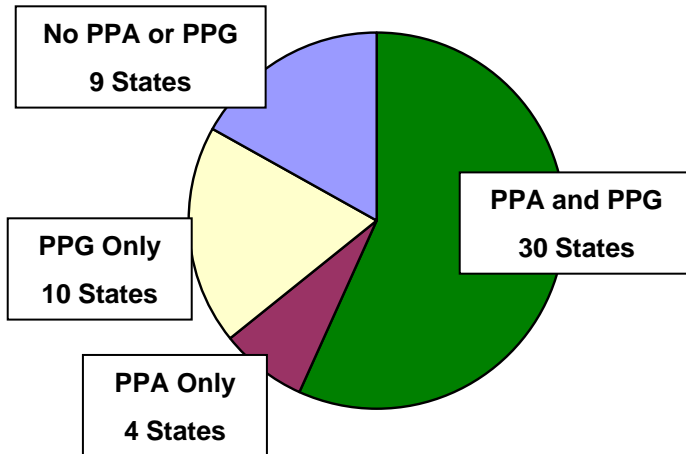

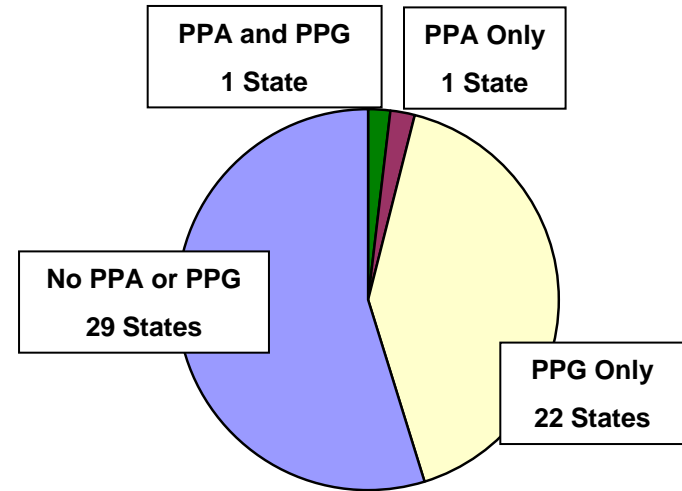

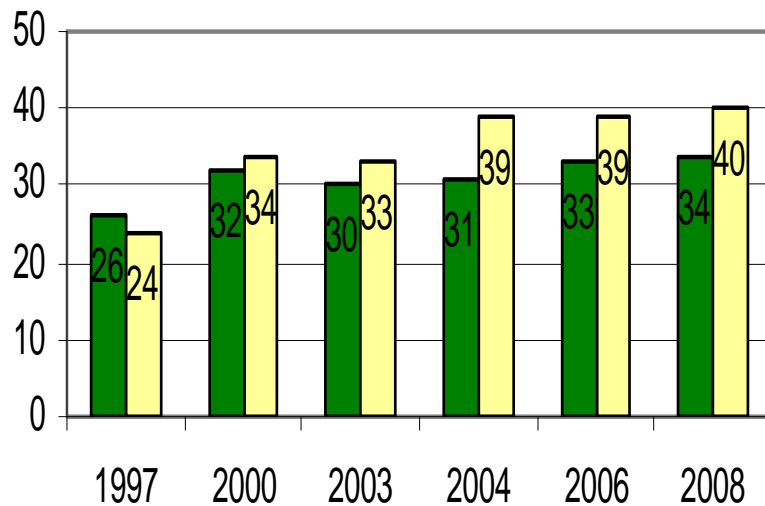

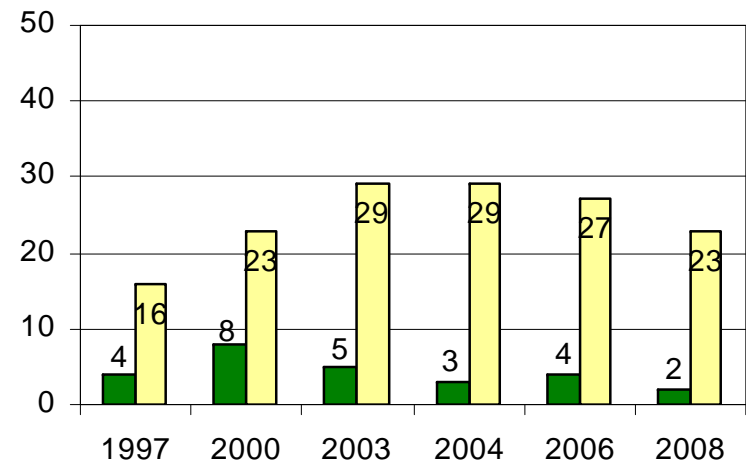

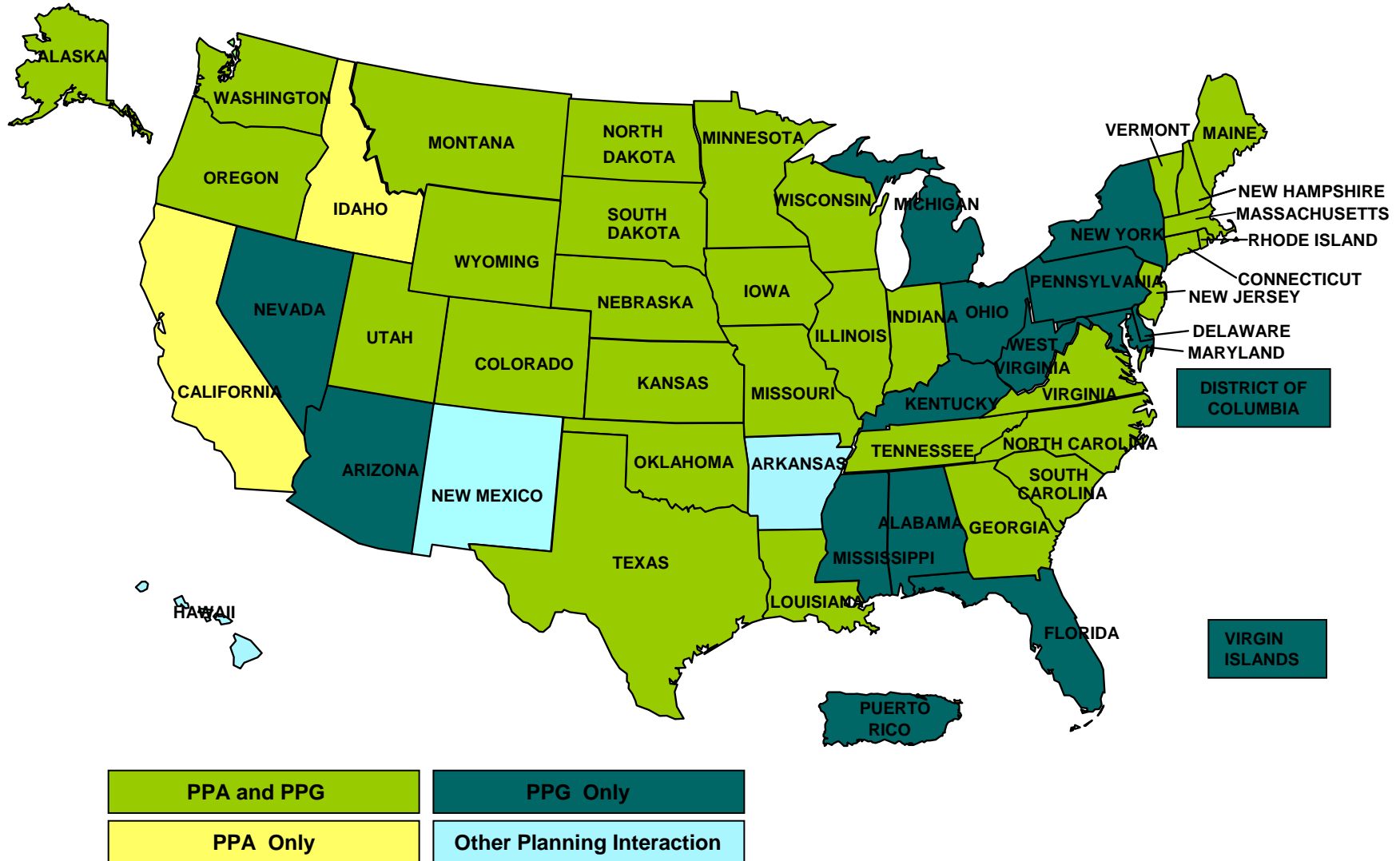

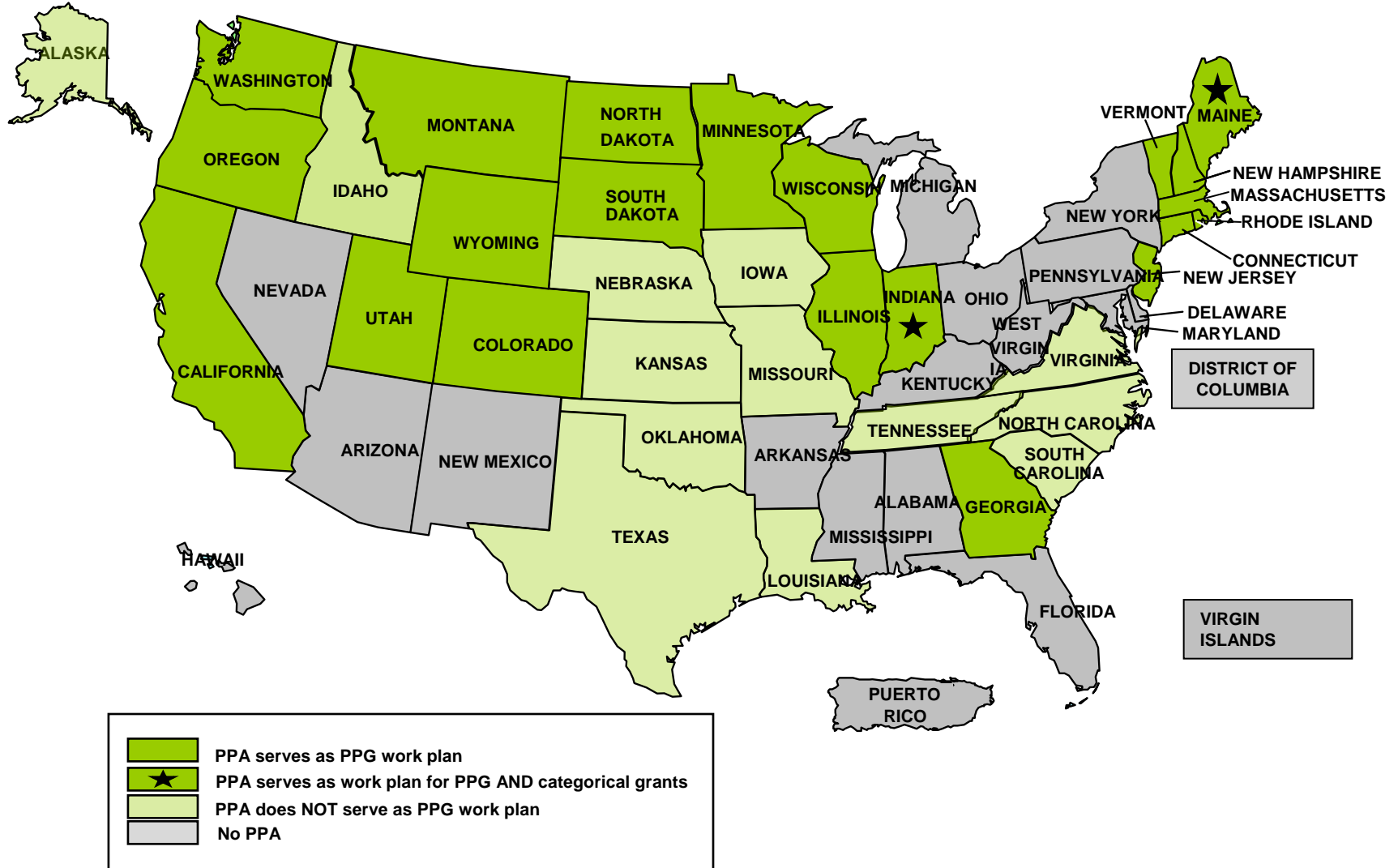
State Environmental & Agriculture Agencies Combined FY 2008

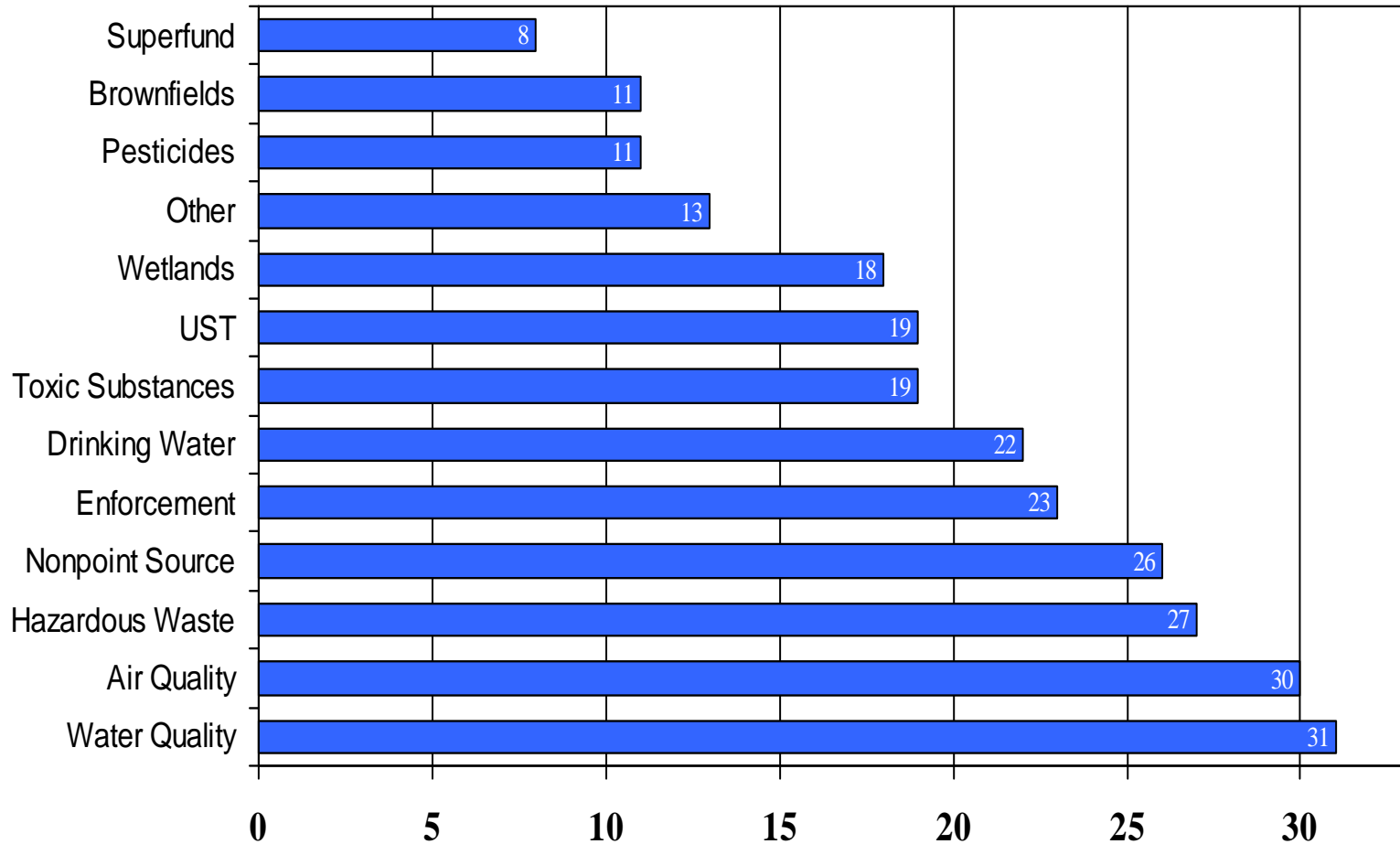

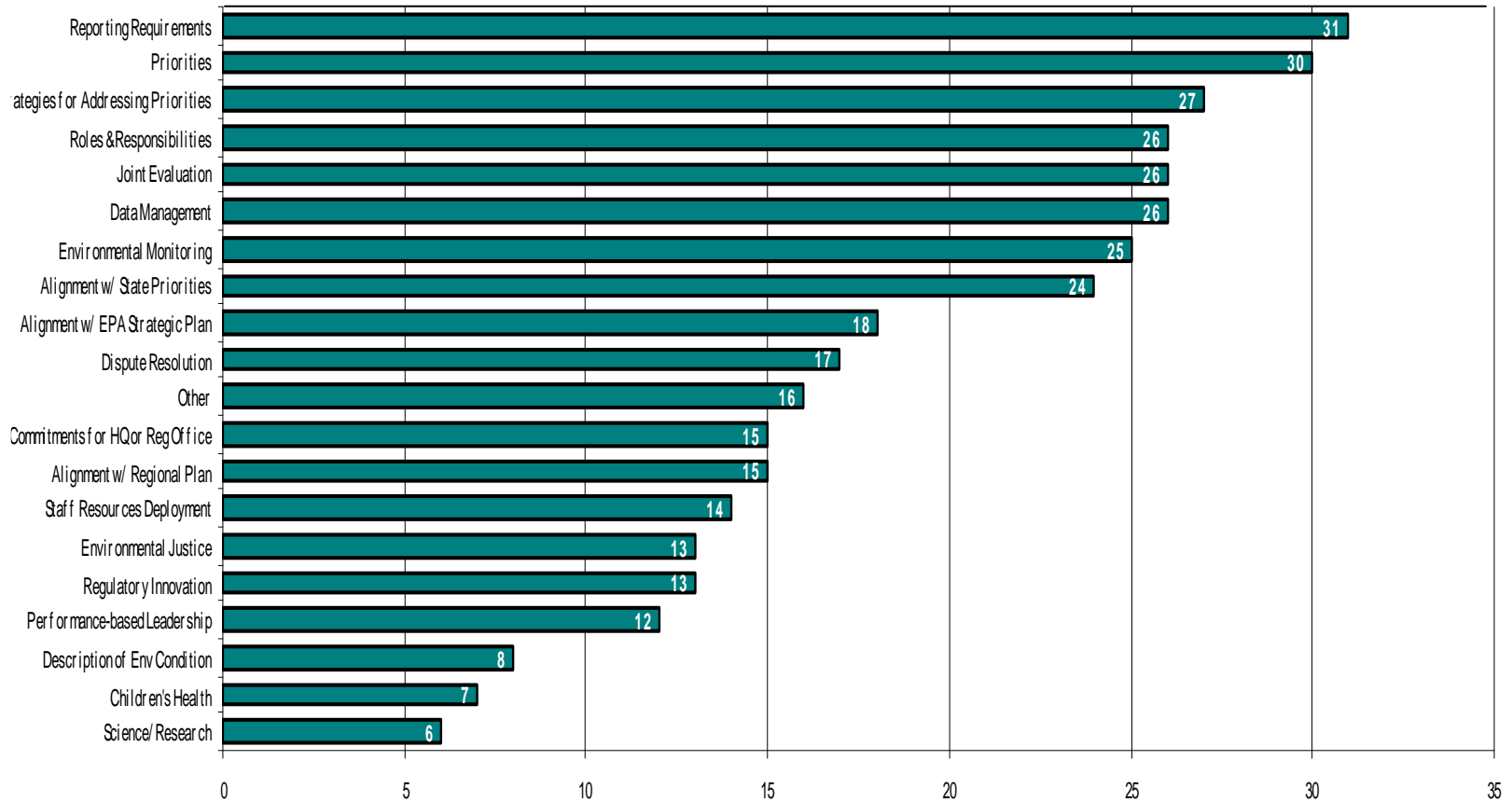

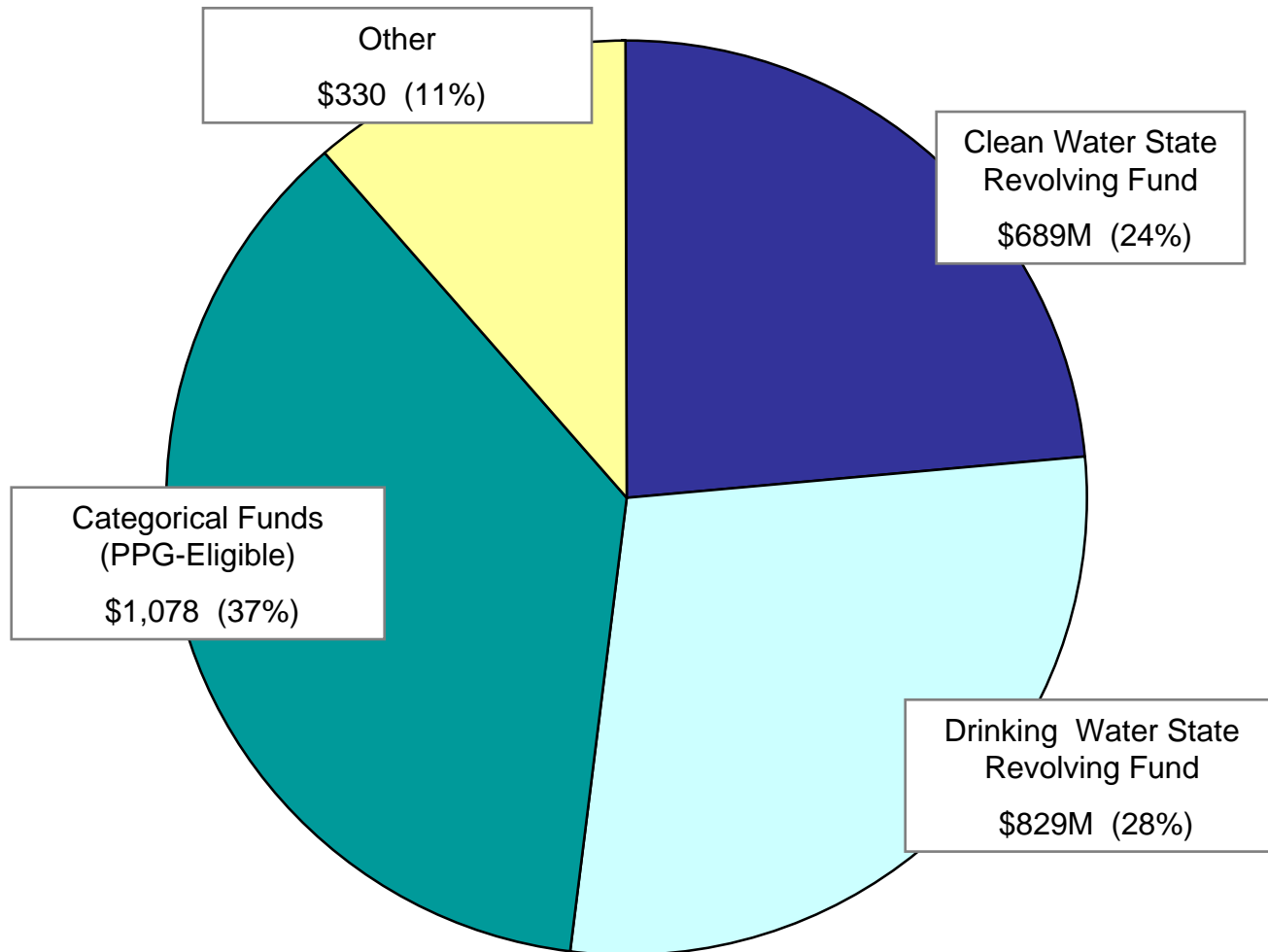
Topics Covered in Performance Partnership Agreements State Environmental Agencies (FY 2008)

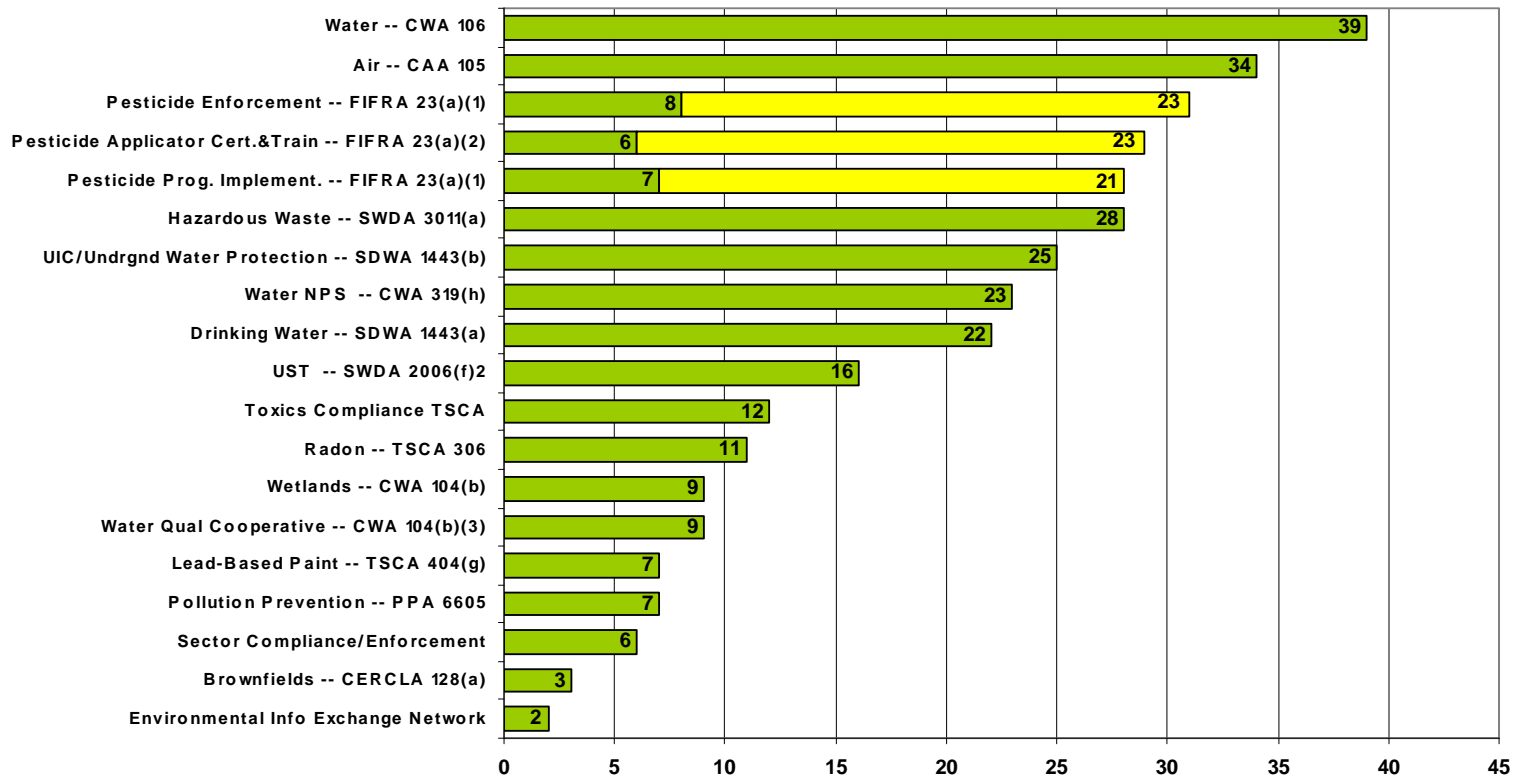




Categorical Grants Combined in Performance Partnership Grants (FY 2008)

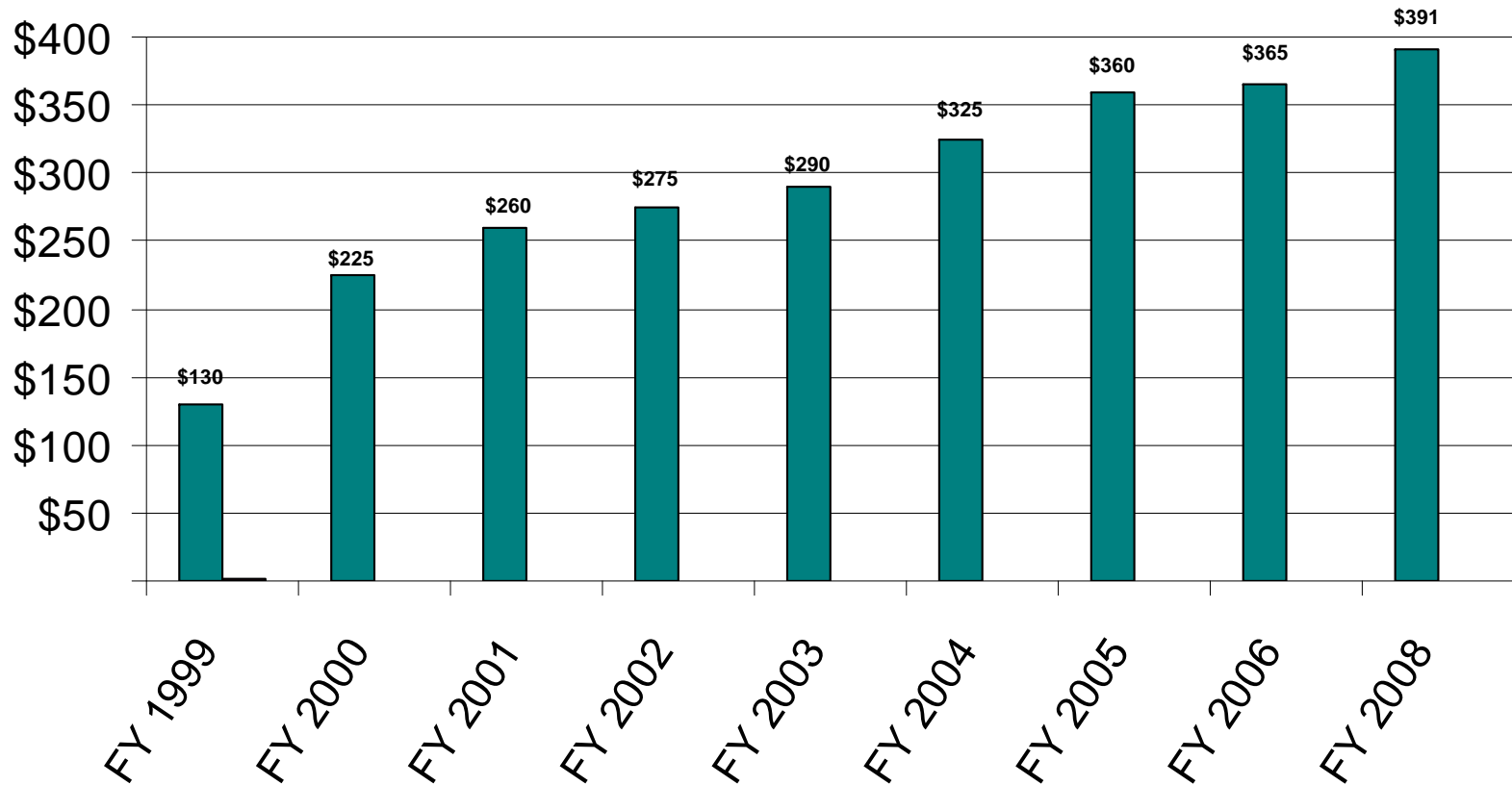

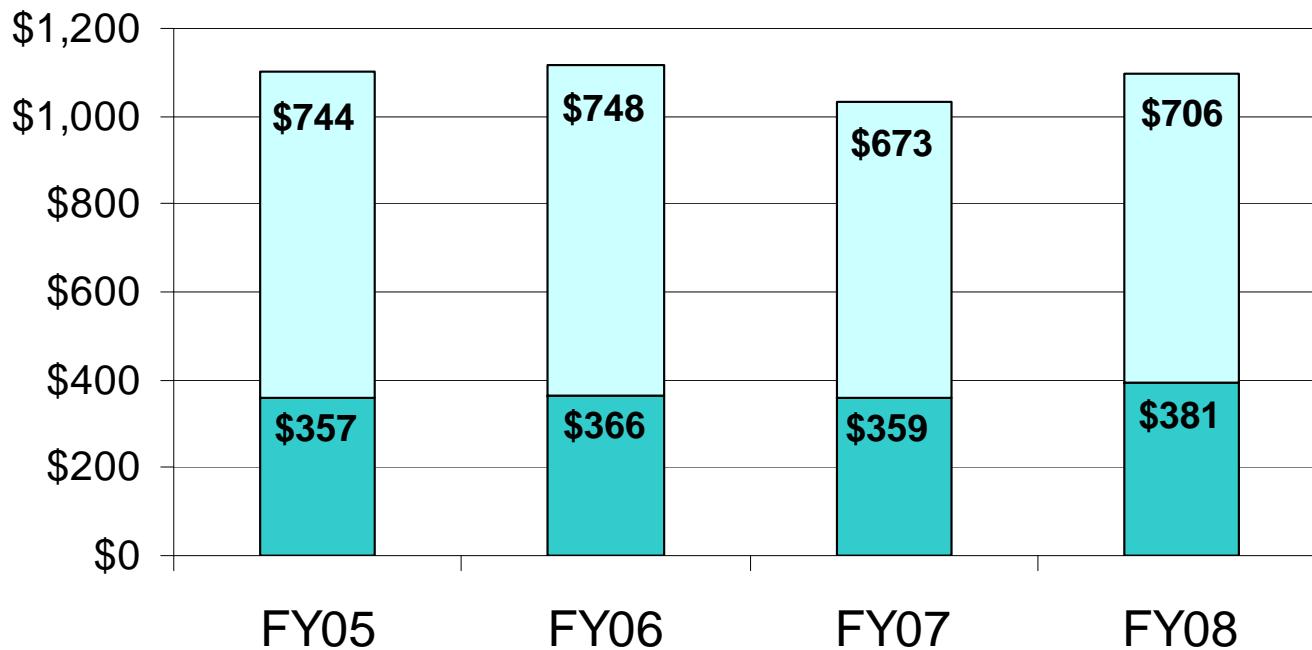
Performance Partnership Grant Funding Levels (1999-2008)

Amount of PPG-Eligible Grant Funds Awarded in PPGs and Categorical Grants



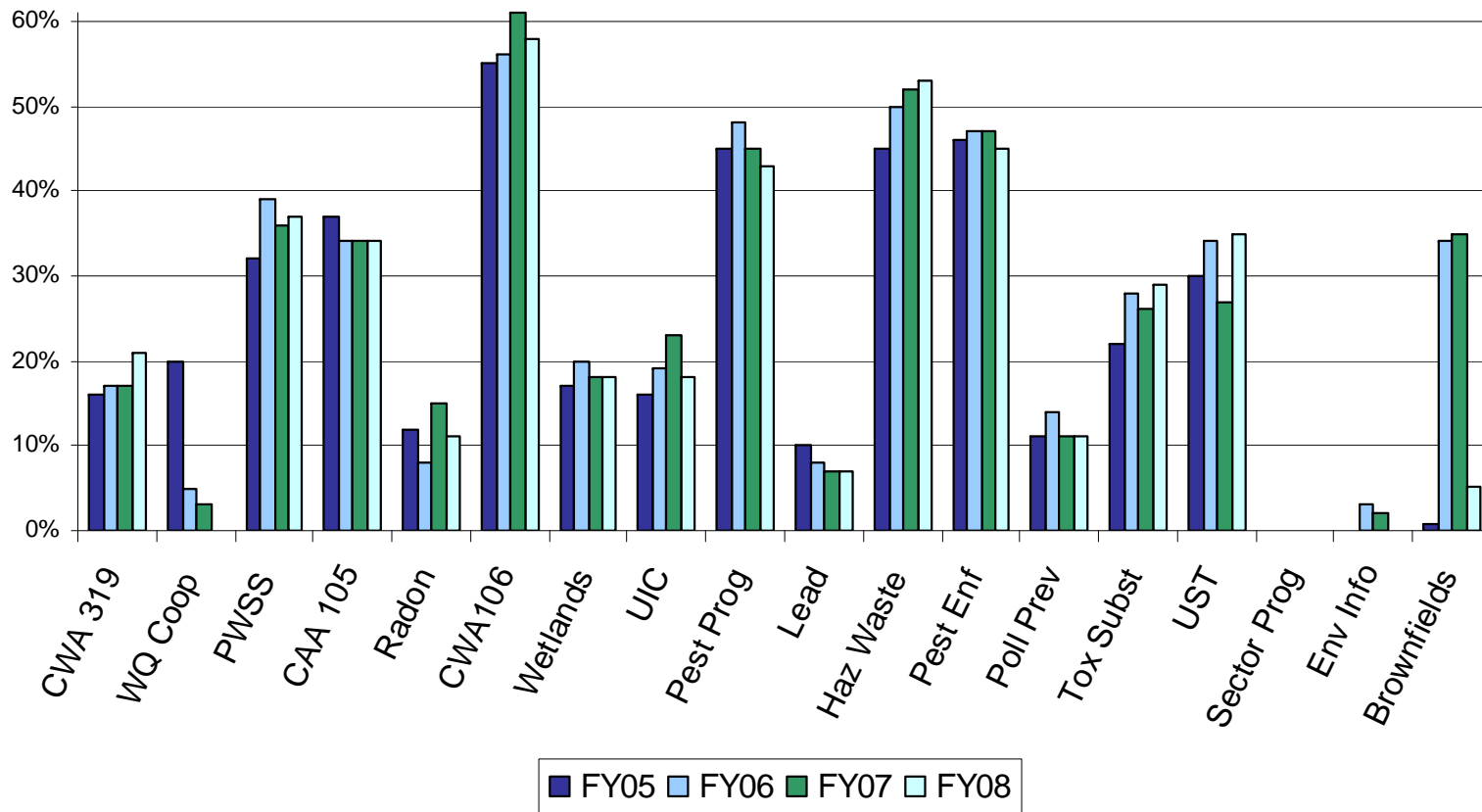
PPG-Eligible Funds Awarded in Categorical Grants

Environmental Program Grants Awarded as Performance Partnership Grants, by Grant Program States and Tribes

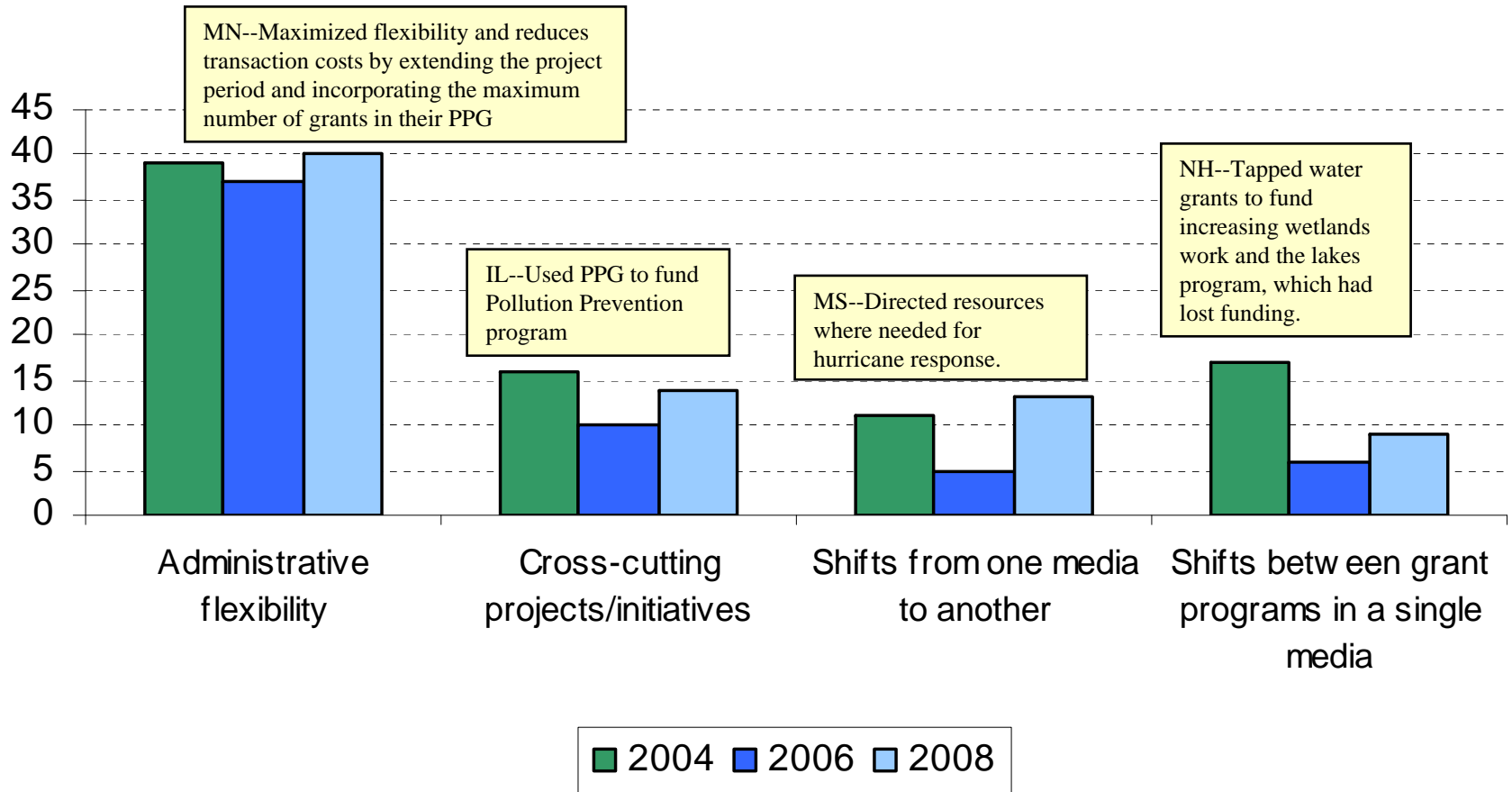
Percentage of PPG-Eligible Funds Awarded in PPGs*
