KINGMAN MAN SENTENCED TO PRISON FOR POSSESSING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

PHOENIX – David Dale Troglin, 65, of Kingman, Ariz., was sentenced here on August 6, 2008 by U.S. District Judge Mary H. Murguia to 78 months in federal prison, to be followed by life time supervision by the court. He was also ordered to register as a sex offender.

In September 2006, Troglin knowingly possessed images and videos of child pornography that he had obtained via the Internet at his residence in Kingman. Troglin pleaded guilty on August 17, 2007 to Possession of Child Pornography. He had a previous conviction in Idaho in 1985 for the felony offense of Sexual Abuse of a Minor under the age of 16.

The investigation in this case was conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The prosecution was handled by Vincent Q. Kirby, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Phoenix.
