## KAIBETO MAN SENTENCED TO OVER 3 YEARS IN PRISON FOR AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

PHOENIX – Julius J. Delmar, 35, of Kaibeto, Ariz. was sentenced on Monday, September 8, 2008 by U.S. District Judge Neil V. Wake to 41 months in federal prison. Delmar pleaded guilty on May 23,2008 to assaulting a female victim with a rope on the Navajo Nation. Delmar was also ordered to placement in an inpatient alcohol rehabilitation program along with three years supervised release at the completion of his prison term.

The investigation in this case was conducted by the Navajo Nation Police Department in Tuba City, Ariz. and the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Flagstaff, Ariz. The prosecution was handled by Roger Dokken, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Phoenix.
