FY08 Accomplishments

In 2008, Kootenai National Forest personnel continued monitoring projects utilizing native plant materials. Personnel visited two of the sites that were seeded in 2007. The native seed mix is establishing well on the mine reclamation site. Personnel also visited two of the recreation sites seeded in 2005 and they are doing well.

In addition, forest personnel continue to work towards establishing a Forest seed mix to be used by force account and contractors. During the field season several collection sites were identified that will need native plant revegetation in the near future.
