2008 Accomplishments

Partnerships:

 Our original partner, Wildlands Restoration Volunteers, was unable to take on the planned project. We are forming new partnerships with the Boulder Ranger District, Americorps, and possibly another youth service group with the target of accomplishing at least two acres of restoration in the Overland Burn area, outside Boulder, Colorado.

Seed Collections:

- Collected seeds of three grasses to be stored over the winter and planted directly into restoration sites in the Overland Burn.
- Set up agreement with the ARP Forest Botanist to collect and increase seed in 2009 to be used for other restoration projects on the Forest. Wildland Restoration Volunteers will continue with this portion of the project.
