Happy Jack Information Center Closes

The Happy Jack Information Center first opened its doors 10 years ago, in August 1997. The center provided many services such as selling maps, issuing wood permits, they reserved campground sites, told ALL of the hunters where the elk and deer were at and answered many, many questions. The location was excellent to accommodate the needs of the public. This prompted the discussion of a new Ranger District Administrative site, which to this day is being pursued by the Regional Office. Now through October 29th the hours at the Information Center are Thursday through Monday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Unfortunately, on October 30th it will close.



Changes in budget direction mean that we have to evaluate the level of visitor services we provide along with other activities like recreation, patrols, and vegetation treatments. "Closing a visitor information location is a difficult decision, however, all of the services that the Information Center provided will still be available, only now through the Blue Ridge Ranger Station. The employees at Blue Ridge Ranger Station look forward to carrying on the proud reputation of good customer service that the Happy Jack Information Center provided and we look forward to serving you." said Mindee Roth, Mogollon Rim District Ranger.
