\* 485 fire rings dismantled

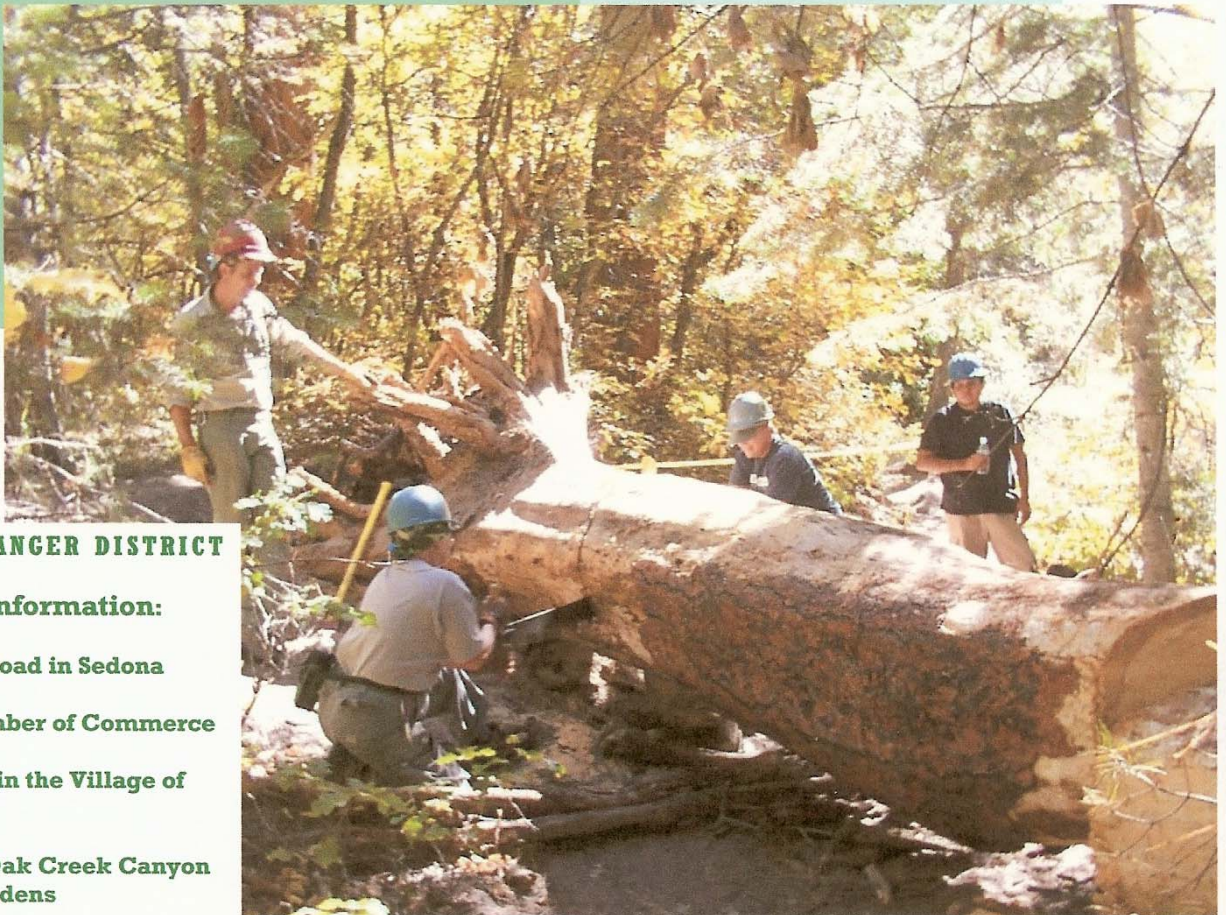
\* 72 transient camps contacted and handled

hiking trails

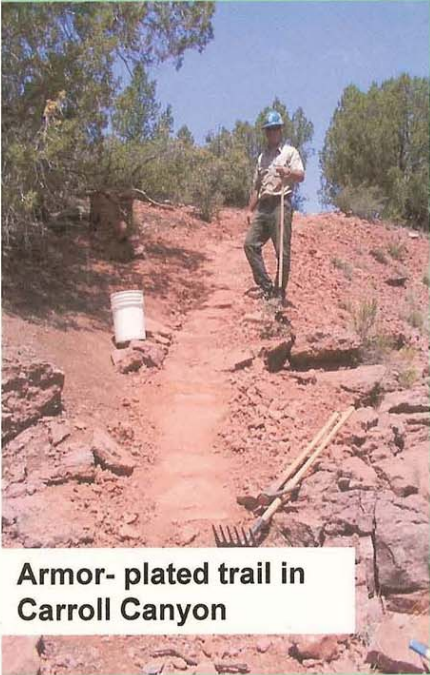

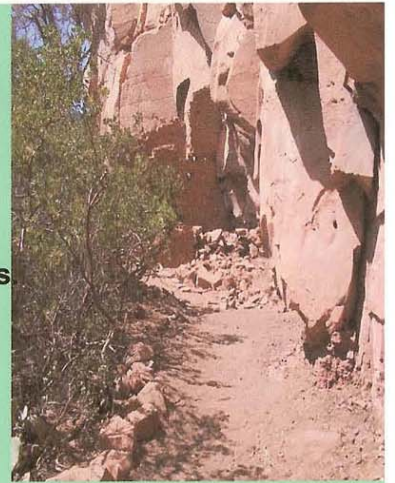
## Red Rock Ranger District Accomplishments made possible with the help of the Red Rock Fee Program from Oct. 2003 to Apr. 2004
