FOREST SERVICE SUMMER JOBS AVAILABLE

HAMILTON, MONT. February 27, 2009—The Forest Service will soon hire temporary, summertime workers for the 2009 field season.

While most temporary employees will not actually start work until late in the spring or early summer, Forest officials will begin reviewing applications and selecting temporary employees by mid-March. As a result, potential applicants are encouraged to complete their applications as soon as possible.

Temporary employees are hired for recreation, fire fighting, range management, wildlife biology, hydrology, engineering, surveying, and clerical jobs.

All these jobs are at the entry-level pay grades (GS-3 to GS-5), with the hourly wages ranging from \$11.74 to \$14.74. Applicants for all temporary Forest Service jobs must be U.S. citizens, at least 18 years old, and may have to pass a physical-fitness test.
