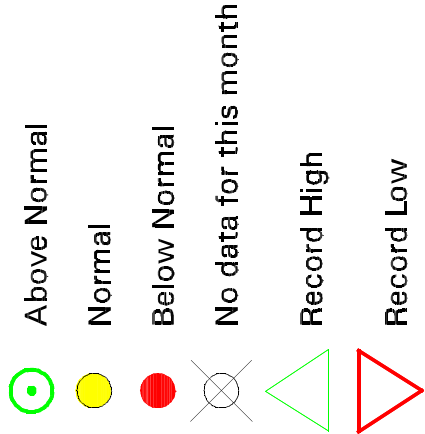
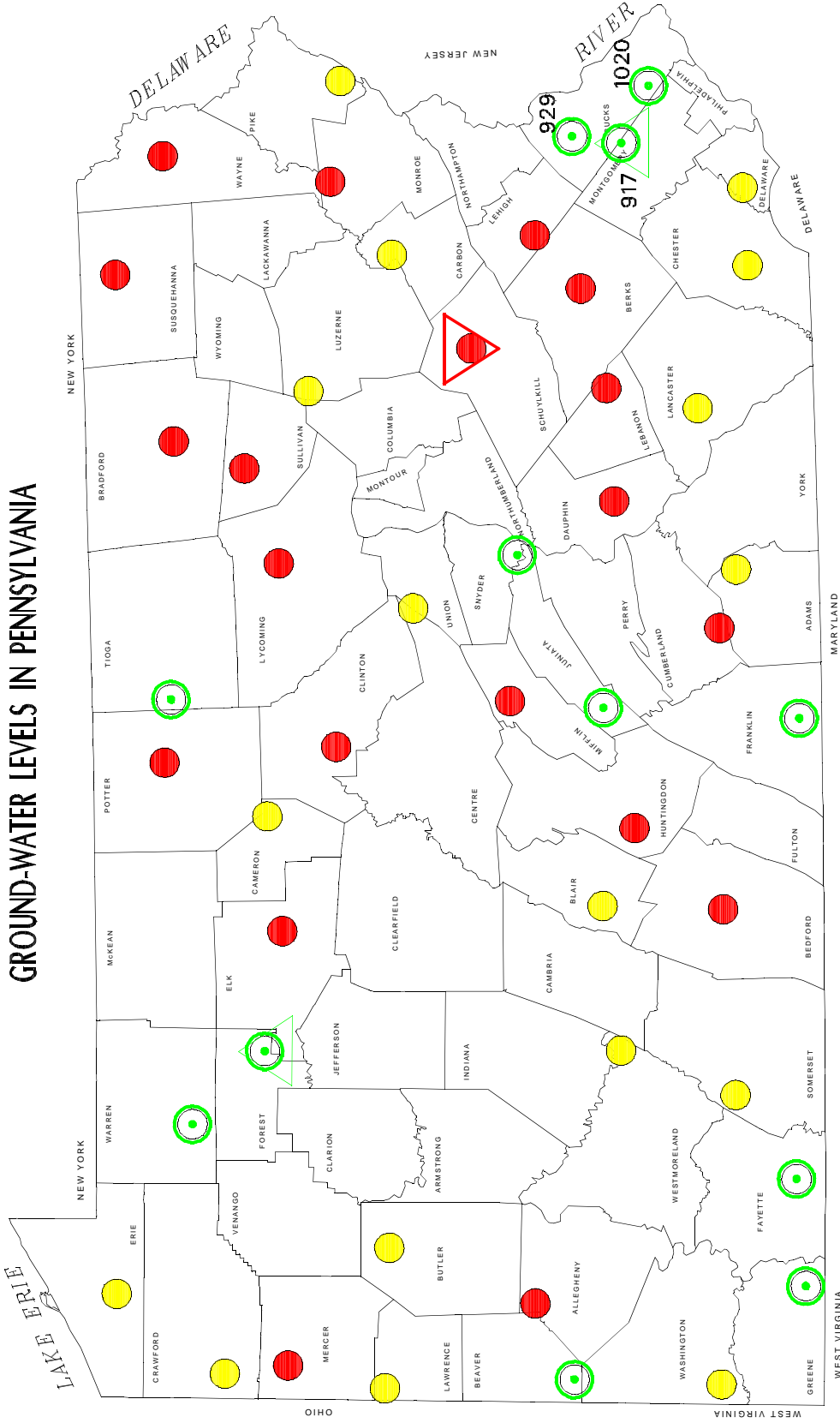
NOTE:
