**FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER
UINTA NATIONAL FOREST INTERIM TRAVEL MAP**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on the areas, roads and trails as described in this order, all within the Uinta National Forest until further notice.

- 1. Use of any type of vehicle on roads when prohibited or restricted as shown on the Travel Map, or when posted on the ground.
[36 CFR 261.54(a)]**
- 2. Use of any type of vehicle on trails when prohibited or restricted as shown on the Travel Map, or when posted on the ground.
[36 CFR 261.55(b)]**
- 3. Use or possession of a vehicle off National Forest System roads as shown on the Travel Map, or when posted on the ground.
[36 CFR 261.56]**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Utilizing undeveloped camping or picnicking areas within 150 feet of a designated Forest development road or trail unless that area is posted closed to camping and/or picnicking.
4. Using an over-snow vehicle on a 12 inch or greater snow base except in areas closed for seasonally for wildlife protection.

AREA DESCRIBED:

All National Forest System Lands located within the boundaries of the Uinta National Forest as it relates to open, restricted or closed areas, roads and trails as designated on the ground and/or as shown and designated on the Uinta National Forest Interim Travel Map.

PURPOSE: To provide rules and standards that will enhance public safety and protection of resources as they apply to Travel Management on National Forest System Roads, Trails and Areas.

EXHIBITS AND IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Exhibit 1, map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same, or similar, acts in the above-described areas.
