- Stock animals are fitted with mesh feedbags or muzzles to discourage erosion due to trailside grazing on native plants and flowers.

- Double walled fuel tanks where possible and perform leak tests regularly

- Establish a comprehensive Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan for handling fuel spills
- As opposed to aerosol, use bulk pressurized refillable spray cans for vehicle lubricants.
- As opposed to aerosol, use pump spray dispensers for cooking oils, personal care products, and insect repellents.

Recycling and Waste Reduction

- Minimize purchasing and use of toxic chemicals in cleaning and maintenance products
 - Use propylene glycol antifreeze instead of ethylene glycol
 - Use synthetic motor oils
 - Use renewable and reusable corncob floor dry sweep for minor spills
