Action Requested

Staff requests that the Board approve a \$706.3 million operating budget and a \$47.8 million capital budget for 2008–09.

Summary

The Board approved an operating budget objective of \$706.3 million on November 7, 2007, including \$15.7 million to fund recommendations from the recent Compensation Study and a 4.6 percent merit pay pool for 2008. New initiatives of \$14.9 million are funded in part by cost savings of \$10.2 million identified in the strategic planning process. The divisions and offices have developed budgets for ongoing operations and new initiatives within the approved budget objective. The following table summarizes the proposed final 2008–09 operating and capital budgets:
