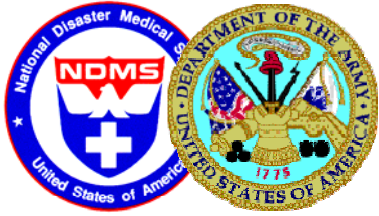
Earthquake occurs in Utah

Activation - The National Response Framework



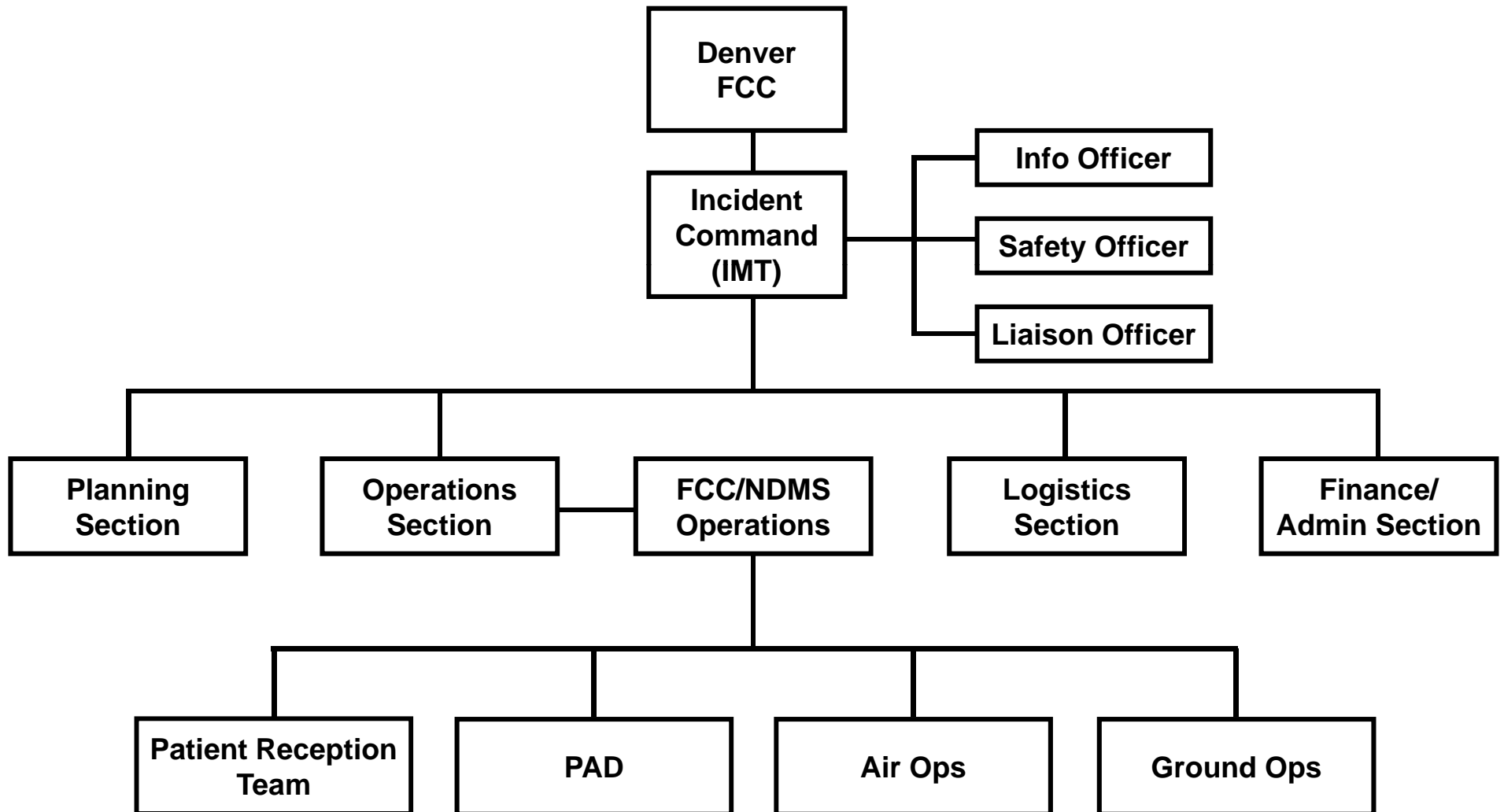
Patient Reception and Movement Concept



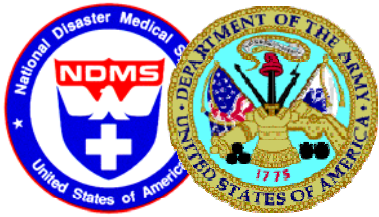

The FCC/NDMS Under ICS

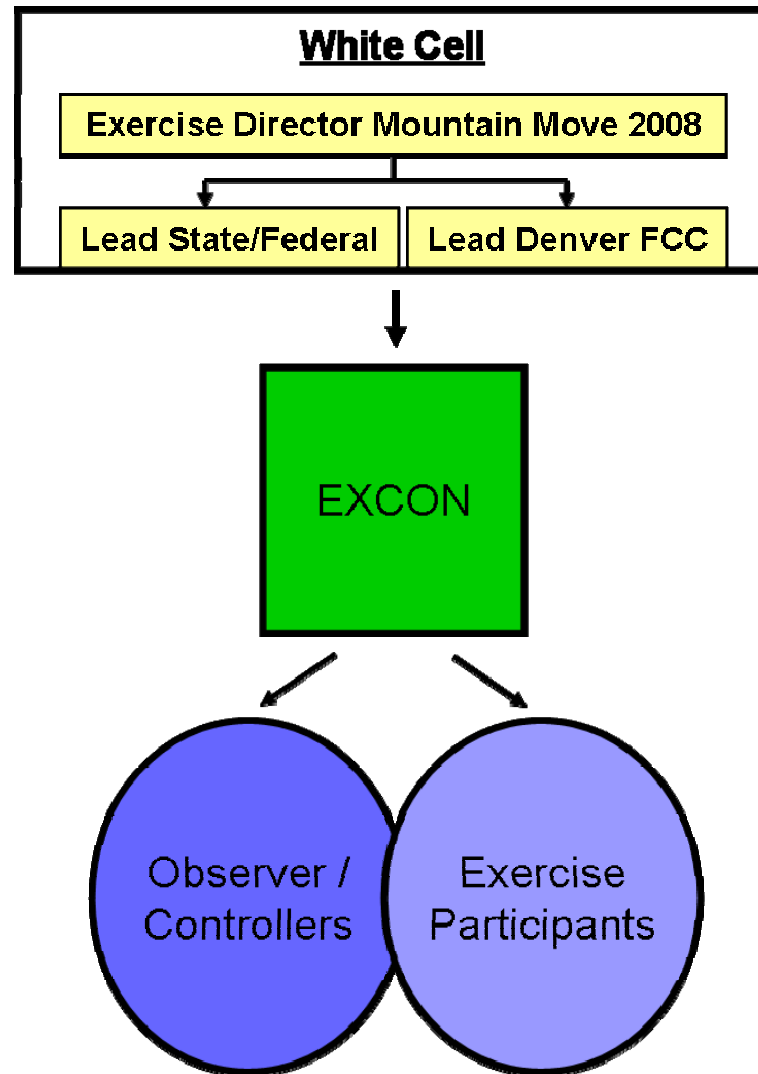

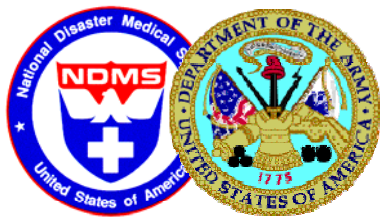

MM08 Exercise Control Architecture

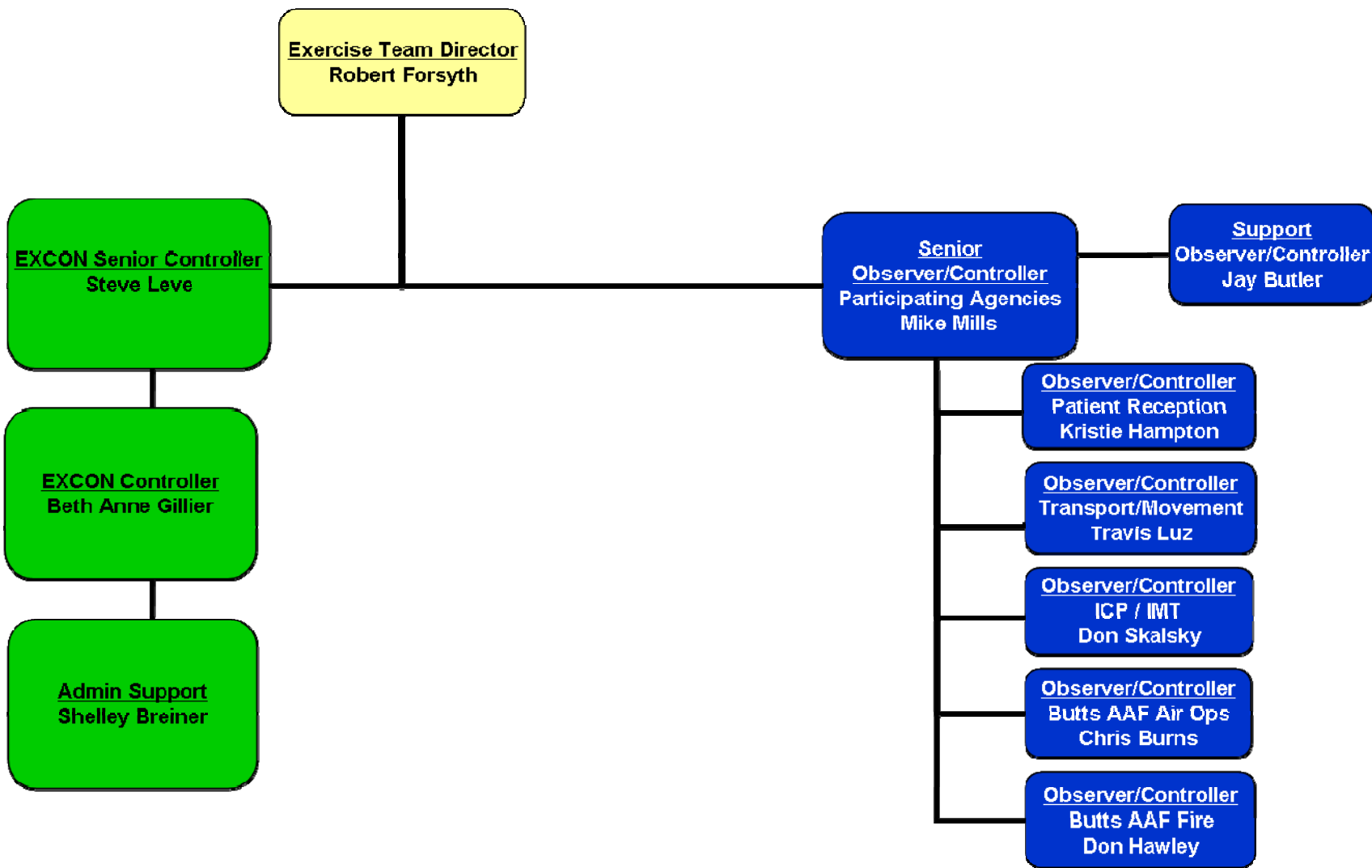

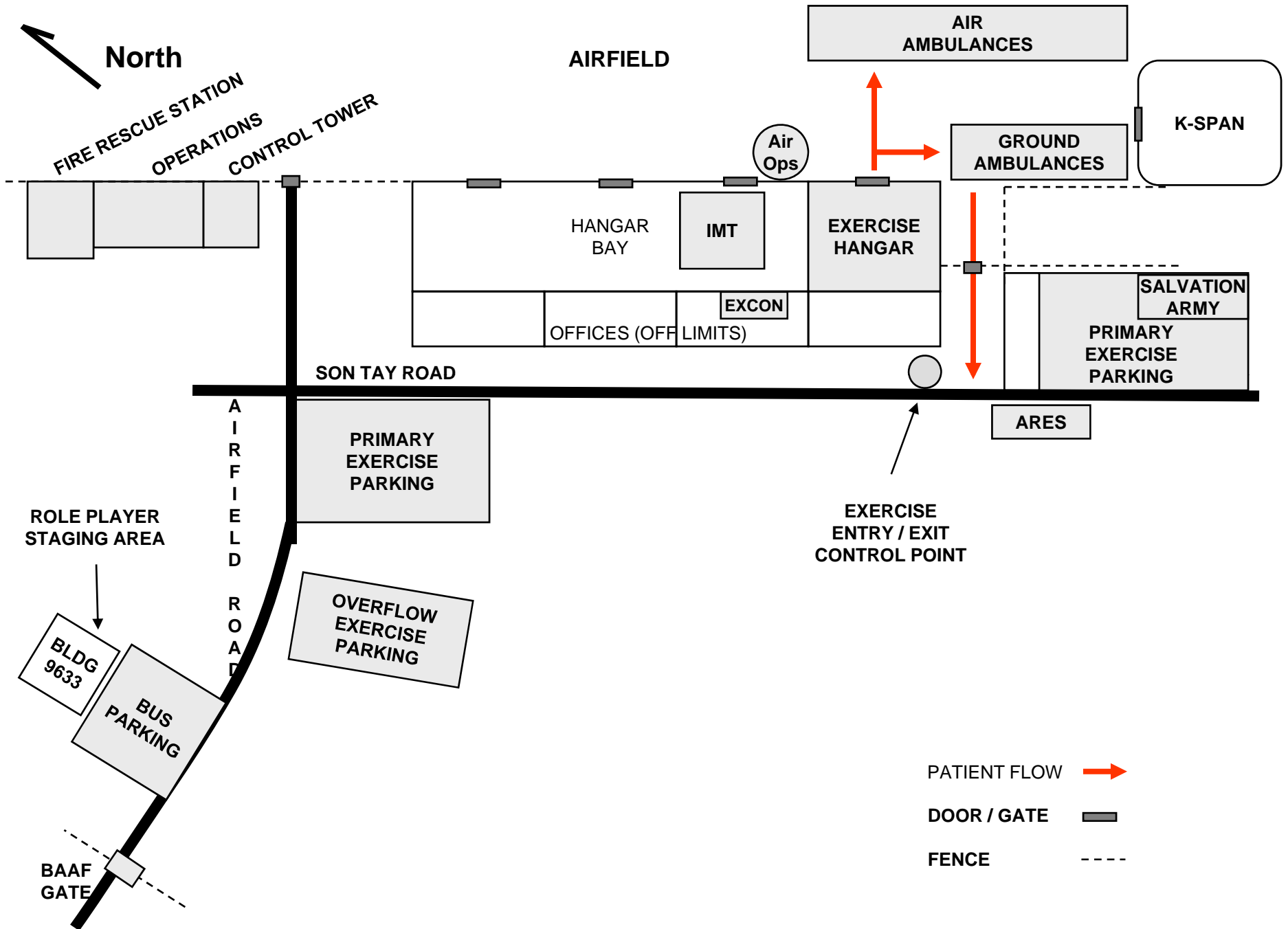

Exercise Area Maps

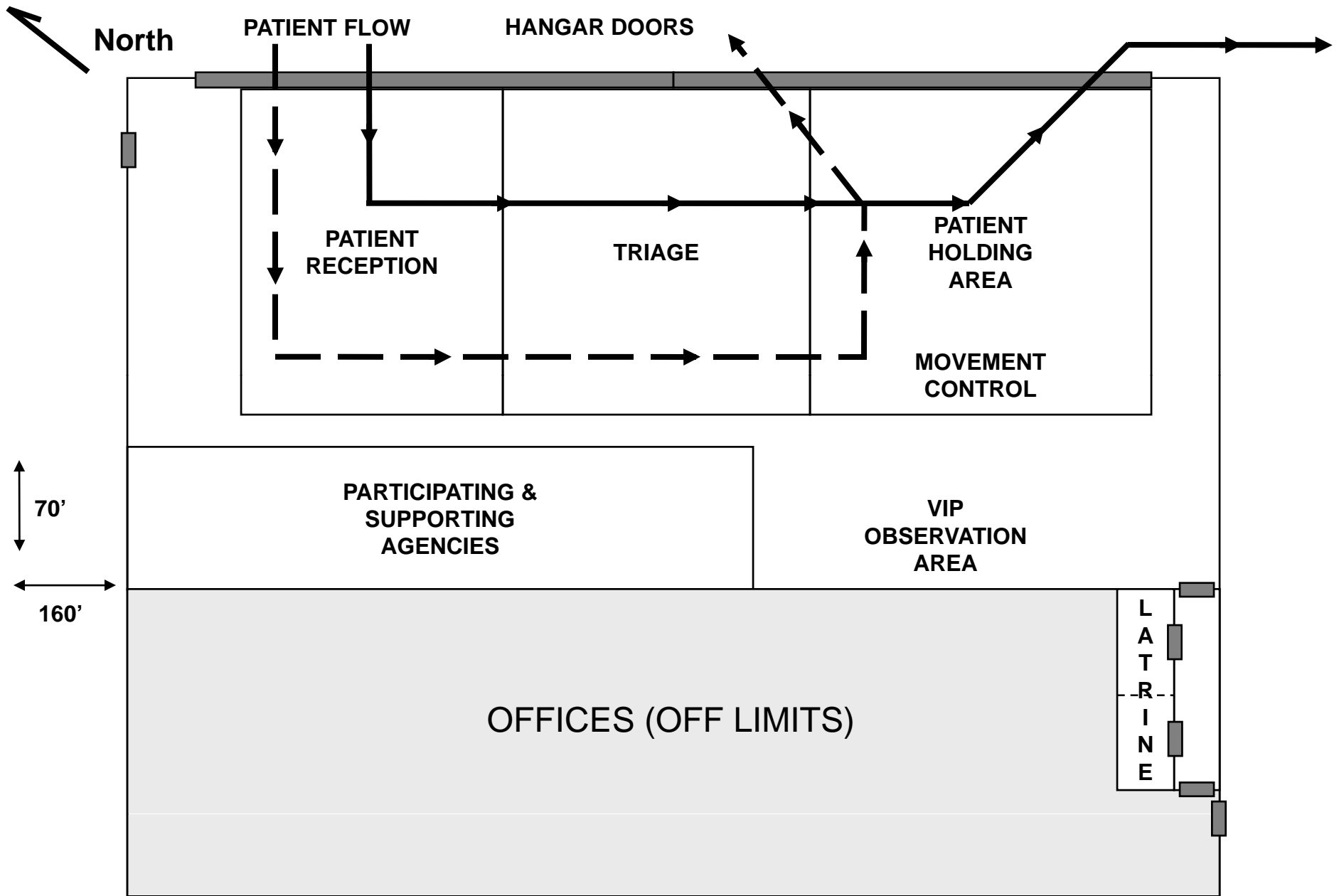

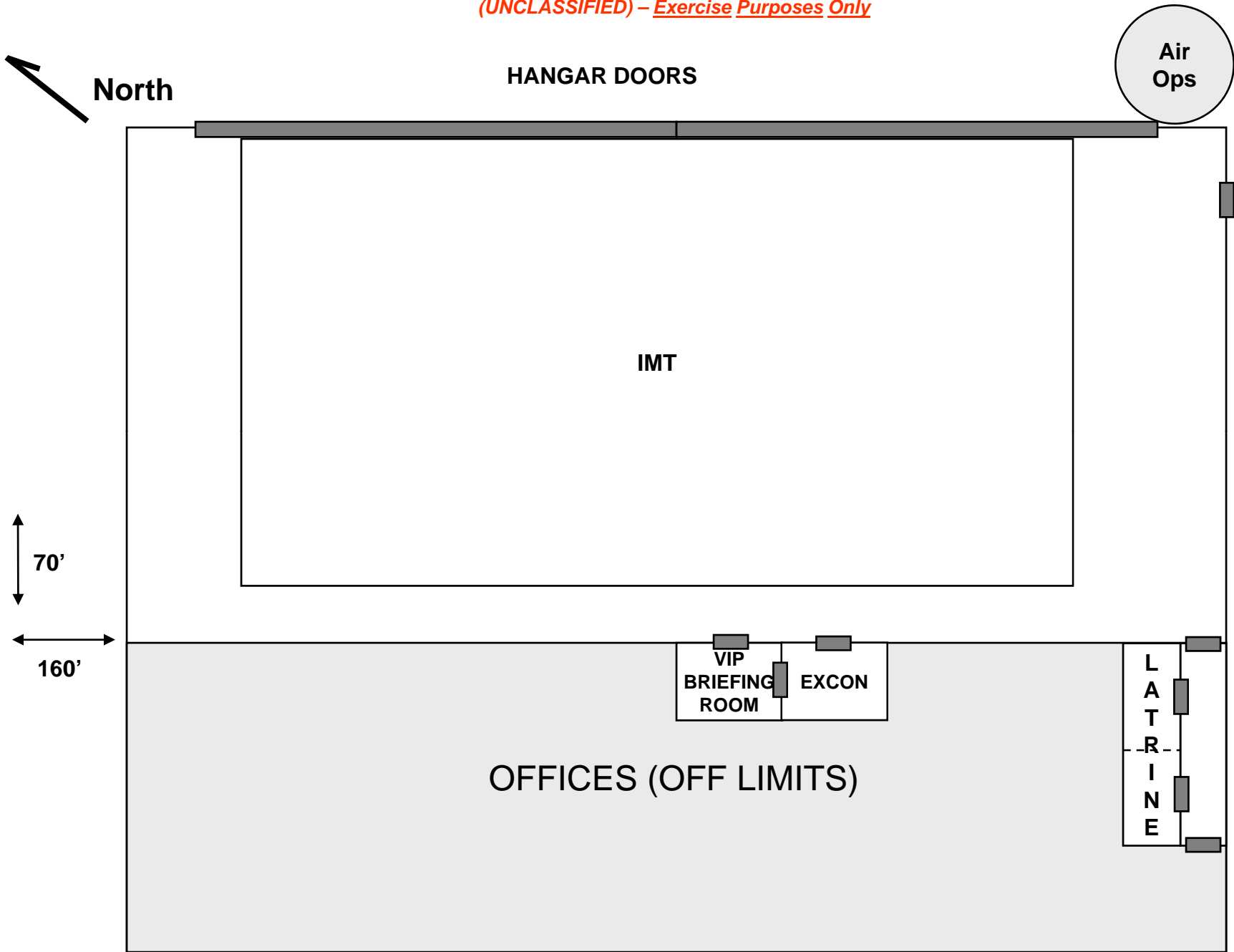
