Re: Conference call with Interactive Data Firms

On August 12, 2008, Chairman Christopher Cox, Senior Adviser Paul Wilkinson and Counsel Christy Romero participated in a telephone call with Philip Moyer, CEO of EDGAROnline, 122 E. 42nd Street, Suite 2400, New York, NY 10168, and Andrew Neblett, CEO of EDGARfilings, 3900 Essex, Suite 900, Houston TX 77027. Mssrs. Moyer and Neblett both submitted formal comments on the Commission's proposed rule on the use of interactive data for company disclosure. The call centered on data tagging and the Commission's 21st Century Disclosure Initiative and solicited information on the needs and concerns of customers and investors related to interactive data. Mssrs. Moyer and Neblett both stated that significant numbers of their customers have successfully tagged their financial statements but have not submitted them to the SEC's Voluntary Filing Program and that companies will be able to comply with the rule as proposed.
