The Enrollment survey includes the following Parts:

- Part A Fall Enrollment Summary by Racial/Ethnic Category
- Part B Fall Enrollment Summary of Students by Age
- Part C Residence of First-time Freshmen
- Part D 12-Month Enrollment and Instructional Activity (formerly collected as part of the Institutional Characteristics survey)

In the pages that follow, the unshaded areas indicate where data need to be provided. Column totals and row totals will be generated by the data collection system.

Part A screens:

- Part A is comprised of 5 screens:
 - Screen 1 Full-time undergraduate students (first-time, first-year degree-seeking and total)
 - Screen 2 Part-time undergraduate students (first-time, first-year degree-seeking and total)
 - Screen 3 Graduate students (full-time and part-time)
 - Screen 4 First-professional students (full-time and part-time)
 - Screen 5 Generated totals (total full-time students, total part-time students, grand total all students)
- The data collection system will generate specific Part A screens for each institution based on the award levels reported on the Institutional Characteristics survey, question B2, in the Fall 2000 data collection. For example, institutions that do not offer any first-professional programs will not see the first-professional screen; institutions that offer only undergraduate programs will not see the graduate screen or the first-professional screen.
- In addition to Total Enrollment (99.0000), enrollment by program for the following 9 selected fields is required this year:
 - 26.0000 Biological Sciences/Life Sciences
 - 52.0000 Business Management and Administrative Services
 - 13.0000 Education
 - 14.0000 Engineering
 - 27.0000 Mathematics
 - 40.0000 Physical Sciences
 - 51.0401 Dentistry
 - 22.0101 Law
 - 51.1201 Medicine

The data collection system will generate screens for each of the 9 programs known to exist at your institution so that you can report students by their major field of study. You will be able to add and delete programs if you need to.

Part B screens:

- Reporting of Part B data is NOT required this year, but Part B screens will be available for your convenience in reporting these data to your state or other entity.
- Total full-time undergraduate students, men and women, will be brought forward from Part A. Age unknown will be generated for each column, as the difference between the total and the sum of the age categories.

Part C screens:

- Reporting of Part C data IS required this year.
- Total first-time, first-year degree-seeking students will be brought forward from Part A. Unknown will be generated for this column, as the difference between the total and the sum of the residence categories.
- The total for those who graduated from high school in the past 12 months will be generated from the detail reported.

Part D screens:

• In Part D, only one answer to question #1 will be permitted by the data collection system. This is indicated by the circles (called radio buttons) that accompany the possible answers. Where radio buttons are used, only one response is permitted (for example, Yes OR No); where checkboxes are used, multiple responses are permitted.
