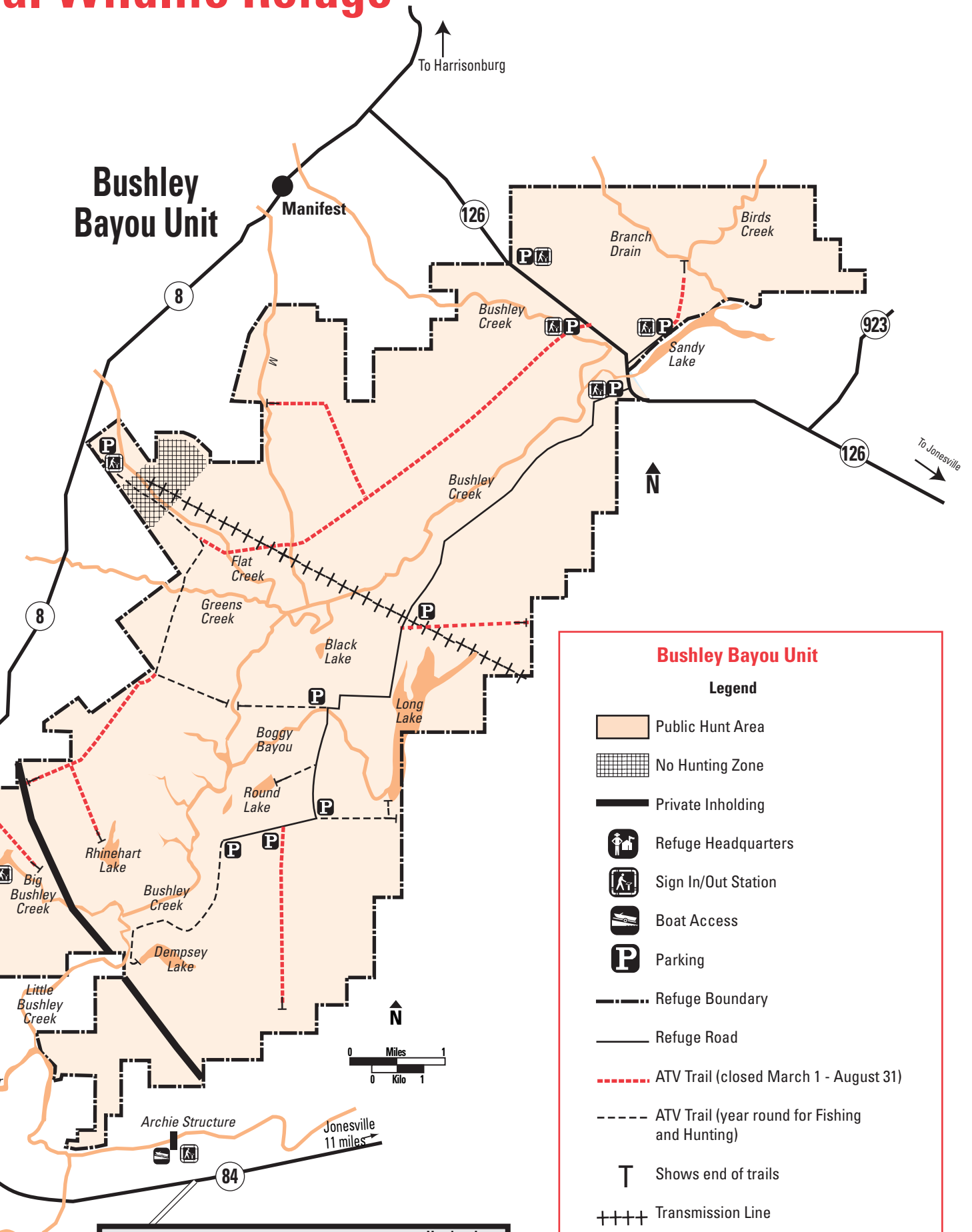

Bushley Bayou Unit

Type	Season Dates	Specific Regulations
Squirrel & Rabbit (without dogs)	October 4 - December 7, 2008	State regulations apply. Closed during deer-gun and deer-muzzleloader hunts. Raccoon and feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Squirrel & Rabbit (with/without dogs)	December 8 - end of State season	State regulations apply. Raccoon and feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Deer - Archery (Either-sex)	State season	State regulations apply. Closed during deer-gun and deer-muzzleloader hunts. One deer per day. Squirrels, rabbits, raccoons and feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Deer - Gun Hunt (Either-sex)	November 28 - 30 December 6 - 7	State regulations apply. One deer per day. Still hunt only. Feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Deer - Muzzleloader (Either-sex)	November 10 - 14 December 20 - 21	State regulations apply. One deer per day. Still hunt only. Feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Waterfowl (with/without dogs)	Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, Sunday until noon	State season. Closed during deer-gun and deer-muzzleloader hunts. Feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Waterfowl - Youth (with/without dogs)	Special state youth waterfowl hunting season, East Zone until 12 noon	State regulations apply. Feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Rails, Gallinules, Snipe, Woodcock (without dogs)	State season - on or before December 19	Closed during deer-gun and deer-muzzleloader hunts. State regulations apply. Feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Rails, Gallinules, Snipe, Woodcock (with/without dogs)	State season - after December 22	Closed during deer-gun and deer-muzzleloader hunts. State regulations apply. Feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.

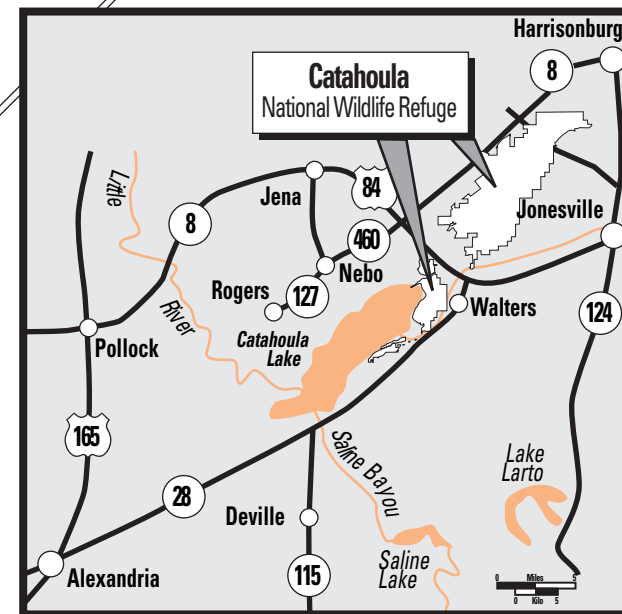

Type	Season Dates	Specific Regulations
Squirrel & Rabbit (without dogs)	October 4 - 31, 2008	State regulations apply. Raccoon and feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Deer-Archery (Either-sex)	State season	State regulations apply. One deer per day. Closed during deer-gun hunt. Squirrels, rabbits, raccoons and feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.
Deer-Gun Hunt (Either-sex)	December 13 - 14, 2008	Area south of French Fork of Little River. State regulations apply. One deer per day. Feral hogs may be taken as incidentals.



Warning: The Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals (LDHH), in conjunction with the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has issued a fish consumption advisory for bodies of water within the parishes of Catahoula and LaSalle that include all waters on the Catahoula National Wildlife Refuge. Women of childbearing age and children less than seven years of age **should not consume** largemouth bass, white bass, freshwater drum, flathead catfish, or bowfin and should consume no more than **two meals per month** of white crappie from the advisory area. Other adults and children seven years of age and older should consume no more than **two meals per month** of largemouth bass, white bass, freshwater drum, flathead catfish, or bowfin and should consume no more than **four meals per month** of white crappie from the advisory area.

Signs and Boundaries

Signs are useful tools in regulating the use of a public area. The wordings of the signs apply to the areas behind the sign. All signs in the field supercede wording in current brochure. Please respect the following signs:



Refuge Boundary
Entry permitted in accordance with refuge regulations.

Closed Area
All entry prohibited.



No Hunting Zone
Hunting, weapons, or game retrieval prohibited.



No Vehicles
All vehicle traffic prohibited including all ATV's, motorcycles, cars, trucks, and jeeps.



ATV Vehicles
Only ATV's are allowed on these trails.
