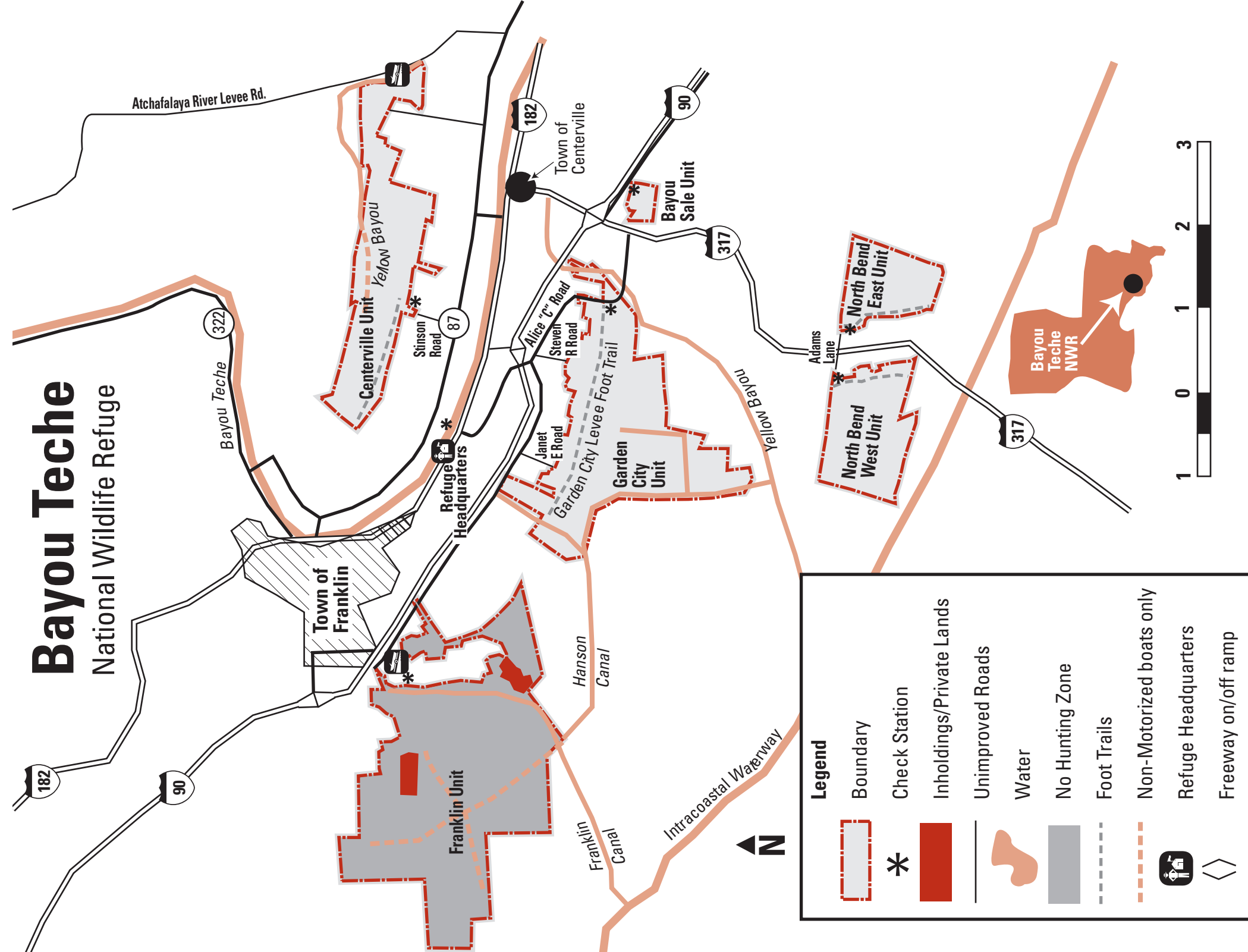

Signs and Boundaries

Please respect the rights of our refuge neighbors. Become familiar with refuge boundaries and avoid trespassing on private land. Signs are useful tools in regulating the use of a public area. The wording of the sign applies to the area behind the sign. Please respect the following signs.



This sign delineates the refuge boundary. Always know the regulations before entering.



All hunting and possession of any weapon is prohibited beyond this sign.



The area beyond this sign is closed to all public entry. Exceptions are stated on sign.

Hunting Regulations 2008 - 2009

Hunters are authorized to take only species listed on season permits and during season dates. Harming or needlessly disturbing plants or other wildlife is a violation of refuge regulations.

Black Bears are Protected

The Louisiana black bear is listed as a threatened species under the provisions of the Endangered Species Act of 1973. This National Wildlife Refuge was established to help conserve this special animal. Do not disturb or harass black bears found on the Refuge. Hunters, please note sightings of black bear on your daily check card.

Be aware that it is unlawful for anyone to take, harass, disturb, etc., any Louisiana black bear. Criminal penalty: up to \$50,000 and 1 year imprisonment.

Be Bear Aware! Do not leave game or snack food available for bears. Always identify your target before shooting. Report sightings on daily check out cards.
