SUBJ: System Impact Reports

1. Purpose of This Notice. This notice cancels N JO 7210.709, System Impact Reports, effective March 17, 2009.

2. Audience. This notice applies to the following Air Traffic Organization (ATO) service units: En Route and Oceanic, Terminal, Service Centers and System Operations Services, including the Directors of Tactical Operations and Traffic Management Officers.

4. Cancellation. This notice cancels N JO 7210.709, System Impact Reports, effective March 17, 2009.

6. Background. The purpose of N JO 7210.709, System Impact Reports, did not correspond properly with the paragraph added in the procedures section. In addition, because of technical issues, the effective date did not allow sufficient time for briefing affected air traffic personnel.
