Bostik is required to perform a trial burn to demonstrate compliance with the hazardous waste management regulations found at 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 266, Subpart H. Bostik is also required to perform a comprehensive performance test to demonstrate compliance with Clean Air Act standards found at 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart EEE. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in consultation with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MADEP) has determined that a single test can be performed to satisfy both sets of regulatory provisions. The trial burn/comprehensive performance test is scheduled to be conducted beginning the week of June 16, 2008 in accordance with the RCRA Trial Burn Plan /MACT Comprehensive Test Plan - Revision 2 – Volume II of III, dated January 21, 2008.
