Key Driver: GPRA (aka Results Act)

Government Performance and Results Act of 1993 provided the foundation.

- Basic Theory: Performance of gov't can be measured & measures are essential to improve gov't effectiveness.
 - Clearly define organizational goals in terms of outcomes
 - Establish metrics & measure performance
 - Improve decision making & accountability for achieving results
- Basic Components:
 - Strategic Plan (minimum 5 year time horizon)
 - Annual Performance Plan (budget) w/measures
 - Performance & Accountability Report

Key Driver: PART

Program Assessment Rating Tool (2002): Evaluation tool used by Administration (OMB) to assess and improve program performance.

- Basic Theory: PART review helps identify a program's strengths & weaknesses to inform funding & management decisions.
 - Annual process done in conjunction with Agency budget development
 - Heavy emphasis on measurement (performance & efficiency)
- Basic Structure: Consistent series of analytical questions, which enable programs to show improvement over time & allow for comparison of similar programs. 25 Core Questions in 4 weighted areas:
 - Program Purpose, Design (20%)
 - Strategic Planning (10%)
 - Program Management (20%)
 - Program Results (50%)

Launched by Deputy Administrator in 2006 along with State Reporting Burden Reduction initiative.

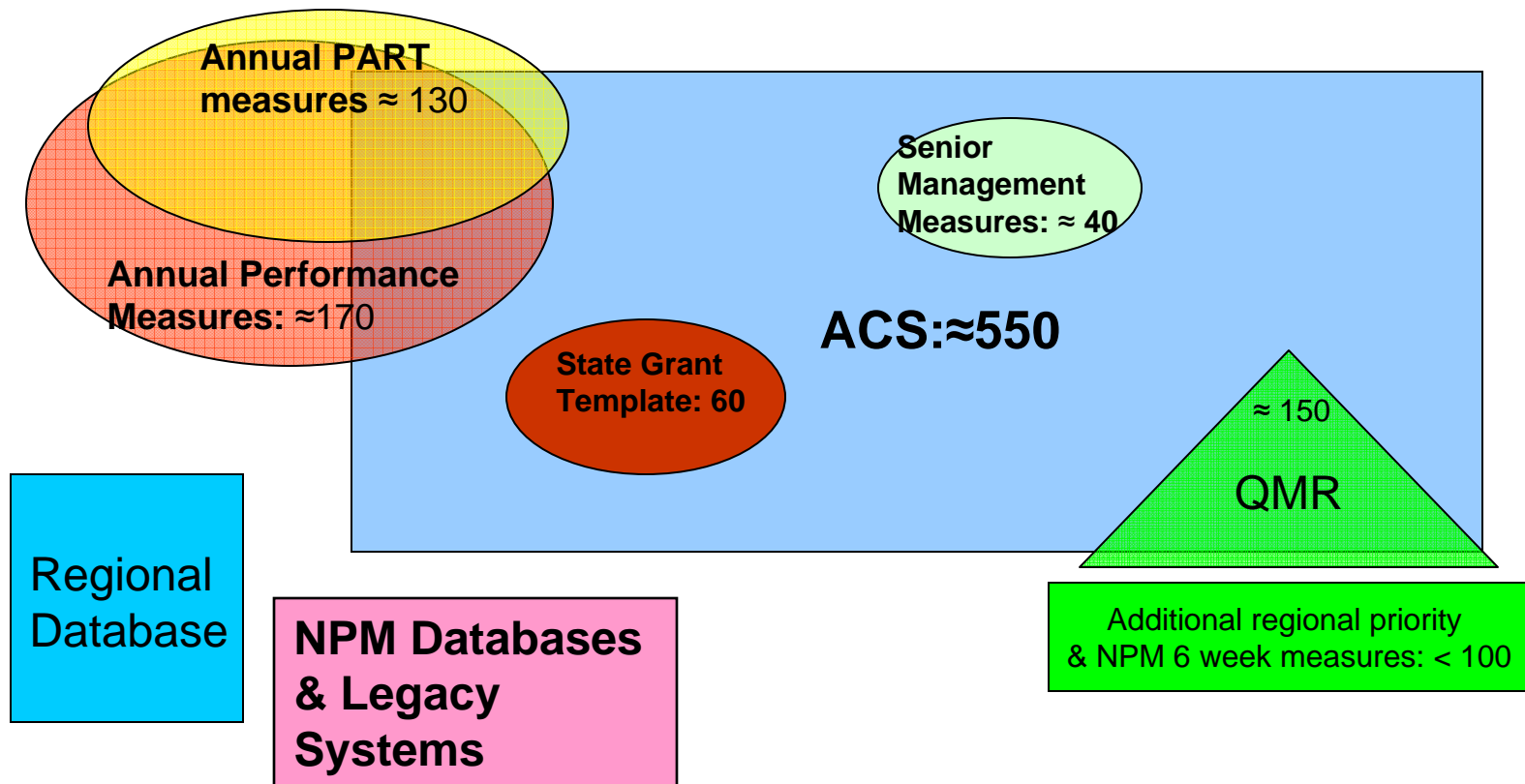
- Purpose: Assess and adjust/streamline performance measures & engage States & Regions in process.
- Year 1 Results:
 - ~15% net reduction in FY 2008 HQ/Reg'l measures
 - Reductions offset by place-based additions
 - Better set of measures
 - Improved transparency
 - Some burden reduction possible in a few areas

Measures Review & Streamlining Initiative

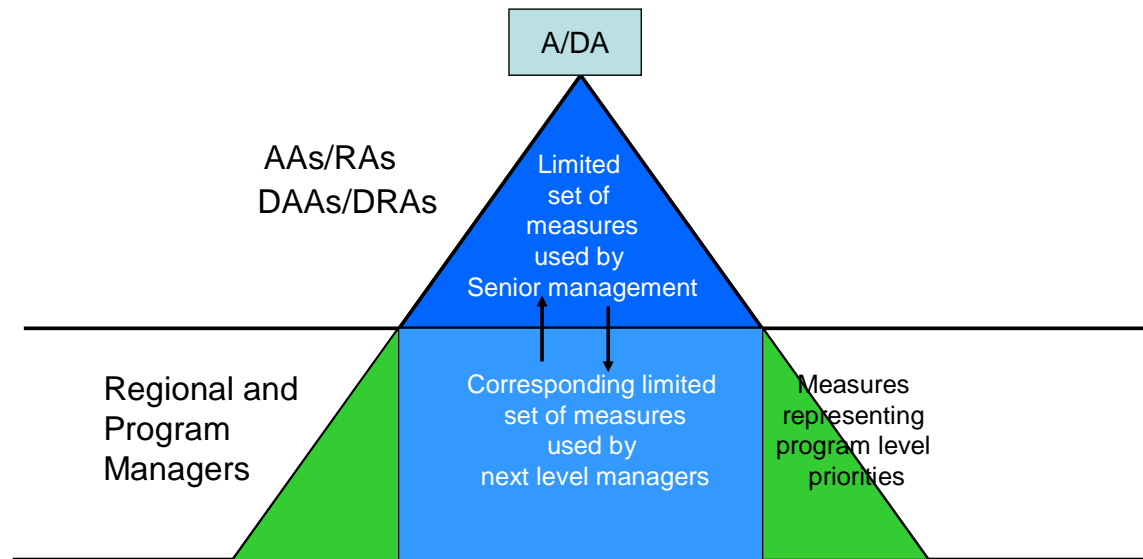
- Year 1 Lessons Learned:
 - Too much attention paid to gross count of measures
 - Perverse incentives to “delete,” but continue to track
 - States unclear on EPA measures framework & process
- Year 2 Approach: “Align & Streamline for '09”
 - Examine broader universe of measures
 - Utilize Agency workgroup of NPMs & Regions
 - Targeted State & Tribal engagement
 - Reduction in measures still possible

Relationship between Measure Sets/Systems FY 2007 (as of June)

EPA is moving toward “Measures Central”: a single repository for Agency performance data



A Different Way of Looking at the Universe of Measures



All of these measures will be housed in a central repository (BAS/ACS)

Quarterly Management Report

A performance mgmt tool w/fresh & frequent data used to help monitor and improve results.

- Efforts Underway to Institutionalize & Improve QMR:
 - Moving QMR data collection to EPA's "Measures Central"
 - Developing formal Change Control process
 - Adding context & improving presentation
 - Aligning data collection periods
 - Accelerating document development & production
 - Gathering requirements for mgmt dashboard

Lessons Learned

- Organizational culture change is difficult & progress is incremental.
- Measuring the right things isn't always easy or cost effective.
- Need to balance # of measures w/burden on Agency & State & Tribal partners.
- Leadership is key—the person at the top largely determines success.
- External factors (e.g., OMB, Congress, less \$) can be great motivators.
- Working w/partners & stakeholders early is critical.
- Linking budget w/Strategic Plan presented challenges.
- Transparency & Accountability have increased.
- Awareness has greatly increased @ EPA & w/State & Tribal partners.

Future Directions

More work to be done to:

- Better link cost and performance.
- Find the right measures, which are cost-effective.
- Institutionalize EPA's performance management system.
- Harmonize and streamline "The Swirl"/system.
- Make performance info more accessible to managers (e.g., dashboard application).
- Continue to improve transparency.
- Effectively engage w/partners & stakeholders.
- Increase dialogue w/external parties on the issue of EPA's effectiveness and efficiency.
