## **Key Objectives for the Network**

- 1.5 The Exchange Network is financially sustainable and partner funding responsibilities are clear ST ~ The Exchange Network has a long-term sustainable financing plan and implements it
- **2.1** EPA Regulatory Flows are all using the Exchange Network
  - ST ~ By 2012 the EPA and States have implemented all national system flows
- 2.3 The Exchange Network updates and/or adopts data standards to ensure data quality and supports expansion of the types of data exchanged
  ST ~ The ENLC will annually identify data standards development and maintenance priorities based on the critical and anticipated Network business needs
