












NJ-GeoWeb A New Vision for Seeking Spatial Intelligence

Integrating customized GIS and analysis tools with enterprise databases for improved decision-making on the Internet

What is: NJ-GeoWeb

- DEP's next generation i-MapNJ on the Interent. Replaces ArcIntelligence on the intranet.
- Uses profiles (roles) that access default data layers and reports (ie. Child Care, What's in My Neighborhood, Smart Growth, Business Viewer…)
- Allows Internet users to view, interact with, analyze and submit points, lines and polygons
- Links to departmental databases (DataMiner, eNJEMS, etc).
- Uses "enterprise" data from all Agencies (and serves from the Web)
- Links to external services on the web.
- Working with OIT make NJ-GeoWeb a state agency resource.








Search Wizard Functionality to Get User to Location or Area of Interest


Mark Ups to ArcMap

- Mark ups can also be imported to ArcMap
- Requires install of Orion Tools toolbar in ArcMap
- Enables connection to OnPoint database, and retrieval of saved mark ups as graphics
- Can be saved in ArcMap to a shapefile


Mark Up Tool Enables Collaboration Between Users




User May Mark Up the Map with Points, Lines, Polys, & Labels




User May Save, Retrieve, or Email Mark Ups to Other Users





Email Received by Other User Provides URL to Mark Up in NJ-GeoWeb





The URL Launches NJ-GeoWeb Zoomed to Saved Mark Up











NJ-GeoWeb: Advantages

- Deployed on Intra and Internet
- Integrated Cross Media/Program Data by Department or state government (federal??)
- Customized Views as a Enterprise Function
- GIS Analysis Power (Buffer, Search, Delineate, etc)
- Direct Connect to NJEMS
- Security Tools
- Integrates with the State's IT Enterprise as a Best Practice
- What's Next: Migrate to ArcServer; build more profiles (roles)

NJ-GeoWeb Profiles

- NJ-GeoWeb will consist of profiles (themes) each focusing on a DEP program or department-wide theme.
- NJ-GeoWeb will enables rapid development and deployment of profiles.
- Profiles include default spatial data to data from NJEMS, COMPASS, Air/Radiation, etc...), custom searches, and linked reports (Data Miner).
- Security allows access to be limited (ie. Water infrastructure)
