The Health Promotion Research Branch in the Behavioral Research Program, Division of Cancer Control and Population Sciences of the National Cancer Institute (NCI) is announcing plans to recruit a dynamic and experienced scientific expert to serve as a Health Scientist Administrator (http://cancercontrol.cancer.gov/hprb/). Candidates should have a strong interest in providing scientific leadership for health promotion and cancer prevention and control research programs of national and international scope. This is a full-time position. Formal position announcement is pending.

The qualified applicant <u>must</u> have doctoral level training (Ph.D., Sc.D., Dr.P.H., M.D. or equivalent) <u>and</u> substantial research experience in one or more of the following areas of cancer prevention and control: behavior science, clinical or cognitive psychology, behavioral nutrition and disease prevention, obesity prevention, exercise science and disease prevention, skin cancer prevention, preventive medicine, and/or other relevant scientific disciplines. Expertise in multi-disciplinary scientific methods (including both quantitative and qualitative methods) relevant to health policy, exercise science, nutrition science, and gene by behavior interactions is preferred. In particular, demonstrated expertise in various study designs and methodologies relevant to behavioral assessment and behavior change (e.g., nutrition/diet, obesity prevention, physical activity, sun safety) within a multi-disciplinary or trans-disciplinary context across childhood and adulthood is highly desirable. Demonstrated ability in translation of knowledge into practice is also desirable. Applicants must be U.S. citizens.

The location is Rockville, Maryland, close to Washington, D.C. Salaries are very competitive and commensurate with experience. Excellent benefits are provided. Relocation package is included.
