MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

14 October 1964

SUBJECT: Chronology of Events of 2-5 August 1964 in the Gulf of Tonkin

1. The report forwarded herewith contains the events, in chronological order, surrounding the naval engagements on 2 and 4 August 1964 between the U. S. destroyers MADDOX and TURNER JOY and North Vietnamese Naval PT boats.

2. In-so-far as the SIGINT aspects of the action are concerned the report is as complete as the need for documentation of SIGINT involvement appeared to necessitate. Documentation presented by the non-SIGINT portions of this report is only as complete as DIRNSA's receipt of relevant messages allowed.

3. A similar report is in preparation covering the 18-19 September incident in the Gulf of Tonkin.

INTRODUCTION

The following report presents the details, generally speaking in chronological order, of the events surrounding the 2 and 4 August attacks by North Vietnamese PT boats on Desoto Patrol vessels, the destroyers USS MADDOX and USS TURNER JOY, in international waters off the coast of North Vietnam.

Desoto Patrols, accomplished to assert the right of U. S. vessels to patrol in international waters and for the purpose of collecting intelligence, were established in April 1962 and have operated since in waters off the China and North Vietnamese coastlines.

equipped with one manual Morse position, one HF/VHF voice intercept position, one VHF/UHF position and a capability for the collection of ELINT signals.

As a matter of routine NSA, prior to each such patrol, provides for both SIGINT tasking of the collection facility aboard the destroyer and for SIGINT support to the destroyer. In the instance of the August Gulf of Tonkin patrol SIGINT support, if in the form of SIGINT reports, was to be sent to the USS MADDOX via a Naval SIGINT was the guard for the MADDOX and NSA25X3 station at would assure that all relevant SIGINT reports reached the MADDOX. Provisions were also made for any SIGINT producing unit to transmit critical information in their possession directly to the MADDOX. Additionally, technical support required by the SIGINT collection unit aboard was made available to the MADDOX prior to her departure, with arrangements in effect for transmission to the MADDOX of additional technical information of high relevancy as it became available.

The destroyer initially involved in the patrol, the USS MADDOX, was from a carrier task group of which the aircraft carrier USS TICON-DEROGA was the flag. While the MADDOX patrolled in the Gulf of Tonkin the TICONDEROGA with her supporting destroyer screen and other support vessels stood to sea south of the entrance to the Gulf. It was from this task force that air support and the second patrol destroyer, the USS TURNER JOY, was drawn following the attack against the MADDOX on 2 August.



In reading the following report it may be helpful to bear in mind that messages originated by CTG 72.1 came from the USS MADDOX, and those from CTG 77.5 were from the USS TICONDEROGA. USN-414T. indicated on some messages as the originator, was a Marine contingent at USM-626J (Phu Bai, SVN) charged, in conjunction with USM-626J, with the collection, processing and reporting of North Vietnamese naval communications. The SIGINT reports included in this document are, in each instance, followed by a copy(s) of the actual DRV message(s) on which the SIGINT report was based. It should also be borne in mind that, aside from the SIGINT information which is as complete as the purpose of this report appeared to require, this report is based only on that information available to NSA and does not purport to contain all relevant non-SIGINT information.

CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS - $3\emptyset/31$ JULY THROUGH AUGUST 1964

1. During the night of 39/31 July, a marine operation was conducted under CINCPAC OPLAN 34A. This action, involving two boats of the so-called "Nasty" type (specially built, shallow draft, high speed craft), resulted in the shelling of the island of Hon Me, a few miles off the coast of North Vietnam. A reaction was conducted by PT boats of the DRV Navy and was observed in COMINT. (Tab 1)

2. A Desoto patrol, the destroyer USS MADDOX, with a SIGINT collection unit aboard, was active in the Gulf of Tonkin at the time of the attack. During the attack the Maddox drew off from the scene and stayed well out to sea; however, she observed the "Nasties" retiring south under pursuit by DRV PT boats. By 1 August Maddox had resumed her scheduled patrol which required that she pass Hon Me Island. On that day DRV naval communications reflected trackings of the Maddox by DRV entities. (Tab 2)

2. $192\emptyset24Z$ August. To determine if the Maddox was aware of the planned action against Hon Me, a message was sent to NSAPAC Rep Vietnam (C). The responses to this query indicated that the Maddox was not aware of the action. (Tab 3)

4. At Ø11924Z August, 12 hours and 33 minutes before the DRV attack on the Maddox, USN-27 (San Miquel, Philippines) issued at Immediate precedence to a wide distribution, including ______ a report under the title "DRV Navy May Attack Desoto Patrol." The report warned, based on the interception of DRV naval communications, that an attack on the U.S. vessel was possibly imminent. (Tab 4) At Ø11954Z (30 minutes after the USN-27 warning) the Maddox reported that she had received information indicating possible hostile action. (Tab 5) Evidence that the source of this warning to the Maddox was from SIGINT is presented in Tab 6 (both sides).

5. From this time $(\emptyset 11954Z)$ the action developed as follows

<u>Ø2Ø3Ø2Z</u> August - DIRNSA sent a message to COMSEVENTHFLT, CINCPACFLT and ______advising of reactions to the OPLAN 34A action of 31 July and warning that DRV reaction to the Desoto patrol might be severe. This was five hours before the attack occurred. (Tab 8)

 $\underline{\emptyset}2\underline{\emptyset}4\underline{292}$ August - DIRNSA sent a message directly to the Maddox providing current technical data for its use in on-board COMINT collection and advisory warning. (Tab 1 \emptyset)

 $\underline{\emptyset 2}\underline{\emptyset 8}\underline{\emptyset 7Z}$ August - Maddox indicated that she was being attacked by three DRV PT boats and was opening fire with her five inch guns. (Tab 13)

 $\underline{\emptyset 2\emptyset 9472}$ August - DIRNSA sent a message to the field stations advising them in some detail of the action. This was done to alert them to the action and to explain the reason for the requested vigilance in collection, processing and reporting. (Tab 16)

 $\underline{\emptyset212322}$ August - USN-27 issued spot report follow-up #3 which indicated that Desoto was now under continuous surveillance. The report also indicated that at least four torpedo boats were in position preparing for an imminent attack upon Desoto. (Tab 17)

 $\underline{\emptyset 2 \emptyset 9 4 9 2}$ August - Maddox sent a "Gulf of Tonkin Action SITREP" recapping the 2 August engagement. (Tab 18)

A marine operation, under CINCPAC OPLAN 34A, was also conducted following the 2 August incident. This action was conducted during the period \emptyset 322222- \emptyset 4 \emptyset 25Z. It consisted of an offshore shelling by three "Nasty" craft against the military complex located at the south bank of the RON River and the Ving Son Radar site,

7. On 4 August the following sequence of events led to yet another DRV attack, this time upon both the Maddox and the Turner Joy.

040028Z August - To document all direct COMINT support to the Desoto patrol DIRNSA sent a message to NSAPAC REP PHIL asking for an accounting of all such exchanges between USN-27 and the Maddox. NSAPAC REP PHIL reply on reverse side of Tab 30. (Tab 30)

 $\underline{\emptyset}4124\underline{\emptyset}Z$ August - The Maddox reported that she had received the information indicating attack was imminent and that she was heading southeast at best speed. (Tabs 34 and 35)

 $\underline{\emptyset}21124Z$ August - DIRNSA dispatched a second message to the field stations advising them of additional details and alerting them to possible DRV search and rescue operations leading to possible increased COMINT reflections and further activity. (Tab $2\emptyset$)

 $\underline{\emptyset 21232Z \text{ August}}$ - USN-27 issued a report based on DRV decrypts indicating that the DRV was continuing its close surveillance of the USS Maddox. (Tab 22)

 $\underline{\emptyset21443Z}$ August - The Maddox issued a further SITREP report providing additional details of the Action. (Tab 23)

 $\underline{\emptyset 2233} \underline{\emptyset Z}$ August - The Maddox indicated that she was resuming her patrol. (Tab 26)

 $\underline{\emptyset}3\underline{\emptyset}956Z$ August - USM-626J (Phu Bai, South Vietnam) reported COMINT indications that DRV patrol vessels were possibly converging on Hon Me Island. (Tab 27)

6. Following the action on 2 August, COMINT reflected the North Vietnamese engaging primarily in "mop-up" actions, principally concerned with locating their damaged PT boats and towing them back to ports. Meanwhile they continued to track and report on the U.S. vessels in the Gulf of Tonkin.

 $\underline{\emptyset}41616Z$ August - NAVCOMSTATION Philippines reported that the Maddox thought a DRV PT boat had sunk one of its own boats. (Tab 42)

<u>Ø42052Z August - At this point the need to assure prompt</u> reporting of ______ reactions to Tonkin Gulf activity lead to <u>broadening SRB Lantern to include all pertinent additional non-</u> stations. (Tab 45)

 $\underline{\emptyset512192}$ August - CINCPACFLT issued an operational status report regarding Desoto Patrol and a recap of the 4 August engagement. (Tab 48)

 $\underline{\emptyset 6 \underline{\emptyset 3472}}$ August - The Maddox and Turner Joy were directed by CINCPAC to resume their patrol. (Tab 49)

8. Representative examples of DIRNSA's COMINT reporting of the activities directly and indirectly related to the situation in the Gulf of Tonkin are included. They range from individual translations (Tab 52), to summaries of specific actions or subjects (Tabs 53 and

54), to a summary of all COMINT revealed actions in

which appeared to relate, or possibly relate, to the situation. (Tab 55) These are examples only, continuous reporting was actually accomplished.

9. On the night of 4 August JCS ordered CINCPAC to conduct one time maximum effort air strikes against specified targets in North Vietnam (Tab 56). Following this order the chronology of events, reconstructed from those messages available to DIRNSA, was as follows:

 $\cancel{0}41628Z$ August - CINCPAC ordered COMUSMACV to recall all RVN PTFs active in OPLAN 34A actions to Da Nang, SVN, and to discontinue all OPLAN 34A actions that might be in progress. (Tab 59)

050043Z August - JCS ordered CINCPAC to implement at least portions of CINCPAC OPLAN 37-64. This order was issued "in view of attacks authorized" and "for the purpose of providing a deterrent to enemy action and to be prepared to undertake immediate operations against North Vietnam". (Tab 64)

 $\underline{\emptyset}5\underline{\emptyset}445Z$ August - CINCPAC recommended to JCS additional alerts and further deployment of forces over and above those already directed under OPLAN 37-64. (Tab 66)

 $\underline{\emptyset}51553Z$ August - JCS directed CINCPAC to complete operational planning and preparations for employment of U.S. resources being provided under OPLAN 37-64 and OPLAN 99-64. (Tab 67)

10. COMINT product reporting on a limited basis was accomplished throughout the air strikes. This was due to a low level of North Vietnamese communications activity during and, for a period, after the air strikes. These reports consisted primarily of ______ and DRV radar tracking of the attacking aircraft. An example of NSA SIGINT reporting accomplished with regards to the air strikes is contained in Tab 69.

ON 31 JULY DRV NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS REFLECTED AN "ENEMY" VESSEL FIRING ON THE ISLAND OF HON ME (19-21N 105-56E) AND TENUOUS INDICATIONS OF ANOTHER ATTACK AGAINST AN UNDETERMINED TARGET IN THE BEN THUY GENERAL AREA. TWO, POSSIBLY FOUR, DRV VESSELS REACTED, HOWEVER, THE INTRUDERS APPARENTLY ESCAPED UNHARMED.

2. AT 301730Z SWATOW CLASS PGM T-142, OPERATING IN COMPANY WITH THE T-146, REPORTED, POSSIBLY TO PORT WALLUT THAT THE ENEMY'S ATTACK BEGAN IN THE ANCHORAGE AREA AT HON ME. THE T-142 FURTHER REPORTED THAT EVEN THOUGH NORTH OF THE ISLAND THEY WOULD GIVE CHASE AND TRY TO CATCH THE ENEMY. AT 30/1836Z PORT WALLUT WAS INFORMED BY THE SAME VESSEL THAT "WE ARRIVED AT 19-18N 105-54-42E THE ENEMY TURNED BACK TO THE EAST FROM HON ME." BY 30/1900Z THE DRV VESSELS HAD GIVEN UP THE CHASE AND WERE RETURNING TO PORT.


3. AT 301805Z BEN THUY INFORMED THE T-377 THAT THE "ENEMY HAS FIRED INTO HON ME. K1'S VESSEL HAS BEEN SENT ..., REPORT POSITION TO K2." TENUOUS INDICATIONS OF POSSIBLY ANOTHER SECRET KIMBO


ATTACK IN THE BEN THUY AREA WERE NOTED AT 310120Z WHEN THE T-379 WAS ORDERED TO BRING THE WOUNDED TROOPS BACK" AND THE T-377 WAS OBSERVED POSSIBLY OPERATING IN CONJUNCTION WITH AN UNIDENTIFIED COASTAL ARTILLERY ELEMENT.

4. COMMENT: BOTH THE T-337 AND T-379 (EX T-185 AND T-187) ARE BASED AT QUANT KHE AND OPERATE WITH SOUTHERN FLEET PATROL UNITS. SINCE ONE GROUP (T-377 AND T-379) OF VESSELS WAS CONTROLLED BY BEN THUY AND ANOTHER GROUP (T-142 AND T-146), BY PORT WALLUT IT IS BELIEVED THAT TWO DIFFERENT AREAS WERE FIRED ON BY THE INCURSION UNIT (S).

2. WE DO NOT HOLD THE OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS THE MADDOX WAS UNDER ON THE NIGHT OF 30 JULY, OTHER THAN THE GENERAL OP INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE DESOTO PATROL PROMULGATED BY CINCPAC.

3. BELIEVE IT WAS ONLY BY COINCIDENCE THAT THE MADDOX WITNESSED THE WITHDRAWAL PHASE OF THE NIGHTS ACTION. SOG/MACV PLANNED THE ACTION TO AVOID ANY ASSOCIATION GS INTERFERENCE WITH THE DESOTO PATROL. HOWEVER, CINCPAC WAS AWARE OF THE PLANNED MAROP AND COULD HAVE ALERTED THE MADDOX TO BE ON LOOKOUT FOR MAROPS VESSELS.

SUMMARY OF SIGINT REFLECTIONS OF DRV ATTACK IN GULF OF TONKIN 2-4 AUGUST 1964

DRV NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS FOLLOWING THEIR UNSUCCESSFUL ATTACK ON THE USS MADDOX IN THE GULF OF TONKIN ON 2 AUGUST WERE LARGELY CONCERNED WITH (1) THE RECOVERY AND DISPOSITION OF TWO PT BOATS DAMAGED BY THE MADDOX AND AIRCRAFT LAUNCHED BY THE USS TICONDEROGA, AND (2) TRACKING AND SHADOWING OF THE MADDOX AND THE USS TURNER JOY WHICH BY NOW HAD JOINED THE MADDOX.

IT IS NOW APPARENT THAT THE ATTACK WAS CARRIED OUT BY TOPEDO TAB 53 FLOTILLA 135 COMPRISED OF AT LEAST THREE PT BOATS -- THE T333, T336 AND T339. THE LATTER WAS SUNK WHILE THE T336 SUSTAINED HEAVY DAMAGES; THE T333 APPARENTLY ESCAPED WITH ONLY MINOR DAMAGES. FOLLOWING THE ACTION ANOTHER PT BOAT, THE T146 CONDUCTED AN EXTENSIVE SEARCH FOR THE FLOTILLA. FINALLY LOCATING THE T333 AND T336 ABOUT 1900 HOURS LOCAL TIME ON 3 AUGUST. A TUGBOAT DEPARTED HAIPHONG ON THE 4TH TO TOW THE TWO DAMAGED CRAFT BACK TO HAIPHONE. THUS DRV NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS CONFIRMED THE INFORMATION PROVIDED EARLIER BY THE PILOTS OF THE TICONDEROGA WHO, WHEN DEBRIEFED, REPORTED THAT ONE PT BOAT WAS HIT AND DEAD IN WATER WHILE TWO OTHERS, ALTHOUGH HIT, HAD HEADED FOR THE BEACH. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE TWO PT BOATS WITHDREW TO LACH CHAO ESTUARY (19-46N 105-52E) AT THE MOUTH OF THE SONG MA RIVER JUST EAST OF THANH HOA. INVESTIGATED AS A POSSIBLE REFUGE AFTER THE ATTACK ON THE FOLLOWING DAY.

AFTER THE 2 AUGUST ATTACK, THE MADDOX WAS ORDERED TO RESUME PATROL NORTH AND SOUTH OF HON ME ISLAND (19-21N105-56E) JOINED BY THE USS TURNER JOY WITH AIR COVER FROM THE TICONDEROGA SEAWARD OF THE TWO DESTROYERS TO PRECLUDE ANY OVERFLIGHTS OF THE MAINLAND. DURING 3 AUGUST DRV NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS REFLECTED THE TRACKING AND SHADOWING OF THE TWO DESTROYERS THROUGHOUT THE DAY; THIS ACTIVITY WAS REPORTED BY BOTH DESTROYERS. THEY WERE ALSO APPARENTLY SHADOWED BY TWO PRESUMABLY DRV AIRCRAFT. A DRV MERCHANT SHIP ADVISED ITS SHIPPING OFFICE IN HAIPHONG THAT "TWO BOMBERS" WOUDL "FLY IN THE DIRECTION OF THE SHIP AND INVESTIGATE". NO FURTHER IDENTIFICATION OF THE AIRCRAFT WAS PROVIDED.

ON 4 AUGUST, DRV NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS AGAIN INDICATED PREPARATIONS FOR ANOTHER ATTACK THAT NIGHT. THE T142 AND T146 WERE ORDERED TO PREPARE FOR "MILITARY OPERATIONS". THE T333, WHICH APPARENTLY ESCAPED UNSCATHED AFTER THE FIRST ATTACK, WAS ORDERED TO OBTAIN OIL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SECOND ATTACK. THAT NIGHT THE MADDOX REPORTED EOTH SURFACE CRAFT AND AIRCRAFT APPEARING ON ITS RADAR SCREEN. THEY WERE LATER IDENTIFIED AS HOSTILE AND REPORTED CLOSING IN. THE MADDOX REPORTED AT 144ØZ THAT IT WAS COMMENCING FIRE ON THE CLOSING PT BOAT. SUBSEQUENT REPORTS FROM THE DESTROYER INDICATED THAT TWO PT BOATS HAD BEEN SUNK. THIS WAS LATER CONFIRMED BY A DRV MESSAGE

WHICH STATED "WE SACRIFICED TWO SHIPS AND THE REST ARE OKAY." THE SAME MESSAGE ALSO REPORTED THAT TWO ENEMY PLANES HAD BEEN SHOT DOWN AND ONE DAMAGED AND THAT THIS HAD LIFTED THE MORALE OF THEIR MEN. THERE HAS BEEN NO CONFIRMATION OF THE SHOOTDOWN FROM SEVENTH FLEET ELEMENTS IN THE AREA AND CINCPAC HAS STATED THAT NO U.S. AIRCRAFT WERE LOST IN THE ENGAGEMENT. THERE IS REASON TO BELIEVE THAT FLARES USED TO ILLUMINATE THE BATTLE AREA WERE MISTAKENLY REPORTED AS FALLING AIRCRAFT.

ALTHOUGH INITIAL MESSAGES INDICATED THAT THE T142, T146 AND T333 WOULD BE INVOLVED IN THE ATTACK ON THE U.S. DESTROYERS ON THE NIGHT OF 4 AUGUST, SUBSEQUENT MESSAGES SUGGEST THAT NONE OF THESE WERE INVOLVED. REPORTS FROM THE MADDOX THAT IT WAS UNDER ATTACK SOME SEVENTY NAUTICAL MILES NORTHEAST OF THE NAVAL BASE AT QUANG KHE SUGGEST THAT NAVAL UNITS SUBORDINATE TO THE SOUTHERN FLEET COMMAND WITH ITS HEADQUARTERS AT BEN THUY (NEAR VINH) WERE INVOLVED IN THE SECOND ATTACK.

THIS IS THE FIRST IN A SERIES OF GULF OF TONKIN SIGINT SITREPS WHICH WILL CONTINUE AS LONG AS THE SITUATION WARRANTS. OF THE OTHER REPORTS PUBLISHED, THE MOST RECENT INFORMATION IS CONTAINED, $3/0/VHN/R\emptyset1-64$.

FOLLOWING THEIR 4 AUGUST ATTACK ON THE USS MADDOX AND THE USS TURNER JOY AND PRIOR TO THE U.S. AIR STRIKE AGAINST NORTH VIETNAMESE NAVAL INSTALLATIONS, IT WAS APPARENT IN NORTH VIETNAMESE NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS THAT PLANS WERE BEING MADE TO REGROUP FOR ANOTHER POSSIBLE ATTACK AGAINST THE TWO U.S. DESTROYERS ON THE NIGHT OF 5 TAB 54 AUGUST. MESSAGES WERE OBSERVED BEING PASSED FROM BOAT T142 INFORMING HAIPHONG THAT TWO UNITS OF TORPEDO FLOTILLA 135 AS WELL AS BOAT T146 WERE READY FOR ACTION. PORT WALLUT WAS SUBSEQUENTLY INFORMED BY T142 THAT T146 WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO RENDEZVOUS WITH THE OTHER TWO BOATS AND REQUESTED ANOTHER REPLACEMENT. THESE PLANS WERE BROUGHT TO AN ABRUPT END WITH THE U.S. AIRCRAFT HIT QUANG KHE AND VINH. A MESSAGE WAS PASSED AT Ø626Z, 5 AUGUST, FROM HAIPHONG TO THE BOATS, INFORMING THEM OF THE STRIKE AGAINST VINH AND ORDERING THEM TO CAMOUFLAGE AND DISPERSE.

SIGINT REFLECTIONS OF THE ACTUAL AIR STRIKES AND THE SUBSEQUENT DAMAGE HAVE BEEN EXTREMELY LIMITED IN THAT NORTH VIETNAMESE NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS HAVE BEEN SPARSE SINCE THE AIR STRIKES BEGAN. LIMITED TRACKINGS OF THE APPROACHING U.S. AIRCRAFT WERE REFLECTED BY NORTH VIETNAMESE, RADAR FACILITIES. AT Ø823Z ON 5 AUGUST PORT WALLUT REPORTED TO THE NAVAL DIRECTORATE IN HAIPHONG THAT THREE JETS WERE OVERHEAD, THAT THEY WERE STRAFING THE SHIPS, AND ONE SHIP WAS DISABLED. INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM OTHER SOURCES INDICATES THAT THIS PORT WAS NOT UNDER ATTACK AT ANY TIME; THEREFORE, IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THIS MESSAGE WAS REFERRING TO ANOTHER PORT. OTHER SIGINT REFLECTIONS WERE NOTED IN A MESSAGE OF 5 AUGUST AT Ø626Z WHICH STATED THAT VINH HAD BEEN DESTROYED BY ENEMY AIRCRAFT AND THAT ENEMY AIRCRAFT HAD ALSO DESTROYED NORTH VIETNAMESE SHIPS AT HON ME. IN TOTAL. THE SINKING OF FOUR SHIPS AND THE DAMAGING OF FOUR OTHERS ARE ALL THAT CAN BE ESTABLISHED FROM NORTH VIETNAMESE NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS DURING THE PERIOD 2-5 AUGUST.

NORTH VIETNAMESE MESSAGES DURING THIS PERIOD DO NOT CLARIFY THE NUMBER AND TYPE OF SHIPS INVOLVED. REFERENCE IS USUALLY MADE TO THE FLOTILLA COVER NUMBER OR TO SHIPS IN GENERAL. THUS RECLUDING A CLEAR SIGINT PICTURE OF THE SPECIFIC SHIPS WHICH HAVE BEEN ENGAGED IN RECENT ACTIVITIES.

2 AUGUST/Ø7Ø9Z: SHIP T146 WAS TOLD THAT "THE ENEMY IS A LARGE SHIP ... AND IS 15 DEGREES AT A DISTANCE OF 19 NAUTICAL MILES HEADING 27 DEGREES, SPEED 11 NAUTICAL MILES."

2 AUGUST/Ø716Z: AN UNIDENTIFIED SHIP SAID "WE HAVE CONTACTED FLOTILLA 135 AND ARE ON OUR WAY."

2 AUGUST/Ø944Z: SHIPS T336, ¢142 AND T146 WERE CONTACTED AND TOLD TO "CONCENTRATE TONIGHT AND MEET COMRADE PHAT."

3 AUGUST/ØØ24Z: A MESSAGE TO SHIP T146 SAID THE SHIPS OF FLOTILLA 135 MUST BE ABLE TO BUILD UP A COMBAT (CAPABILITY) AND THAT THE SHIPS MUST HAVE ORDERS FROM HEADQUARTERS PRIOR TO ANY DEPLOYMENT. 3 AUGUST/Ø545Z: THE FIRST INDICATION OF DRV NAVAL DAMAGES WAS CONTAINED IN A MESSAGE FROM SHIP T333 REPORTING SHIP T339 SUNK AND THAT A HEAVILY DAMAGED T336 WAS IN TOW BY T333.

WE SACRIFICED TWO SHIPS AND ALL THE REST ARE OKAY. THE COMBAT SPIRIT IS VERY HIGH AND WE ARE STARTING OUT ON THE HUNT AND (ARE WAITING TO) RECEIVE ASSIGN-MENT." THE REFERENCE TO HAVING SHOT DOWN TWO PLANES MIGHT HAVE BEEN AN ATTEMPT TO BOLSTER THE CONFIDENCE OF DRV NAVAL PERSONNEL.

SITUATION REPORTS MENTION THE TOWING OF DAMAGED VESSELS TO PORT, DESCRIPTION OF BATTLE ACTIVITIES DURING THE AIR RAIDS AND THE PRESENT DISPOSITION OF SHIPS IN THE FLEET.

ON 6 AND 7 AUGUST EXTORTATIONS TO THE FLEET "ORGANIZE FOR MICTORY AND DESTROY THE ENEMY" WERE NOTED. THESE MESSAGES SEEMED TO BE DESIGNED TO SHORE UP THE MORALE OF THE FLEET TO RESIST FURTHER ENEMY ATTACKS.

MESSAGE WHICH INFERS THAT THE DRV SHOT DOWN ONE OF ITS OWN AIRCRAFT ON 5 AUGUST.





THE DRV MAY BE PLANNING A NEW "CONSPIRACY" OF ITS OWN, ACCORDING TO A READÁBLE CIPHER MESSAGE PASSED BETWEEN TWO UNIDENTIFIED NAVAL ENTITIES ON 8 AUGUST. "NO. 44, THE ENEMY IS OBSERVING YOU. GO OUT FROM BAI CHAI HA TU (AS IN TEXT, MEANING UNKNOWN. BAI CHAI PORT IS LOCATED AT $2\emptyset$ -57N $1\emptyset7-\emptyset5E$) (AT) POST 5 (YOU WILL BE) WITHIN THE AREA OF (OUR) NAVAL POWER, THEN FIRE (DONT MOVE) (PARENS IN ORIGINAL TEXT) WHEN THE ENEMY FIRES, THEN ACTIVELY ENGAGE HIM." $(2/O/VHN/R\emptyset5-64)$. ALTHOUGH THE EXACT MEANING OF THIS MESSAGE IS NOT CLEAR, IT COULD BE INTERPRETED AS DRV. INTENTIONS TO PROVOKE AN INCIDENT IN DRV TERRITORIAL WATERS. IT CAN ALSO BE VIEWED AS AN ORDER TO ENGAGE U.S. VESSELS ONLY FROM WITHIN DRV WATERS.



NEVERTHELESS, COMMUNI-CATIONS AVAILABLE SINCE THE ATTACK HAVE BEEN CONCERNED PRIMARILY WITH ASSESSING THE DAMAGE INCURRED BY THEIR VESSELS AND COUNTERMEASURES AGAINST FUTURE AIR ATTACKS. THUS FAR NINE CRAFT HAVE BEEN REPORTED AS EITHER DAMAGED OR LOST DURING THE ATTACK. THIS IS FAR BELOW CURRENT ESTIMATES.

DRV NAVAL AUTHORITIES APPARENTLY FEAR ANOTHER ATTACK. WHILE CLAIMING TO HAVE SHOT DOWN A TOTAL OF SIX AIRCRAFT THEY EXHORTED THEIR PERSONNEL TO BE READY IN CASE OF ANOTHER ATTACK. NAVAL HQ AT HAIPHONE ORDERED UNITS TO DISPERSE AND CAMOUFLAGE THEIR VESSELS. APPARENTLY, IN RESPONSE, VESSELS WERE BEING DISPERSED AROUND THE TAB 69 ISLANDS AND CHANNELS NEAR HON GAY.

EXTENT OF DAMAGES INCURRED BY DRV NAVAL VESSELS DURING THE 5 AUGUST AIR ATTACK AS REFLECTED IN THEIR COMMUNICATIONS SINCE THAT DATE:
