


0318	CRITIC from USN-27 reads in part re DE SOTO "use high speed to go together with ((enemy)) following to launch torpedoes." USN-27 used a USN 414Tx intercept. DTG is 020717Z.
0320	WO wants to know whether to readdress CRITIC to Field Stations/since USN 27 did not use a QUEBEC dist. Told WO to readdress but to take out the words "From USN 414T".
0330	Called Colonel LANG, who said he was coming in.
0335	Called , who said he was coming in; asked whether he wanted me to call anyone else. He replied no.
0340	Lt WRIGHT of ONI (ship plot) asked whether the MADDOX, the DE on DE SOTO patrol, had recyd the CRITIC msg. According to WO, Col LANG states thatautomatically relays msgs to the MADDOX.
0341	Asked T1 to askif it passed the msg and at what time.




