Many of these sections contain verbiage intended to veil the signals intelligence source, but more often than not an intelligent reader would have little difficulty in fully understanding the author's comments.

2. OP 0090 should ask the author, we feel, to delete SI-related materials from the following pages/paragraphs:

- j. para. at bottom p. 80
- k. in its entirety, p. 81
- l. 1st para., p. 82
- m. p. 83, line 1, sentence reading "If they were ... attack."
- n. p. 89, 2d para., 2d sentence, reading "There were various aspects ... than afloat."
- o. p. 100, 2d para., 1st sentence reading "These routine intelligence ... our forces."
