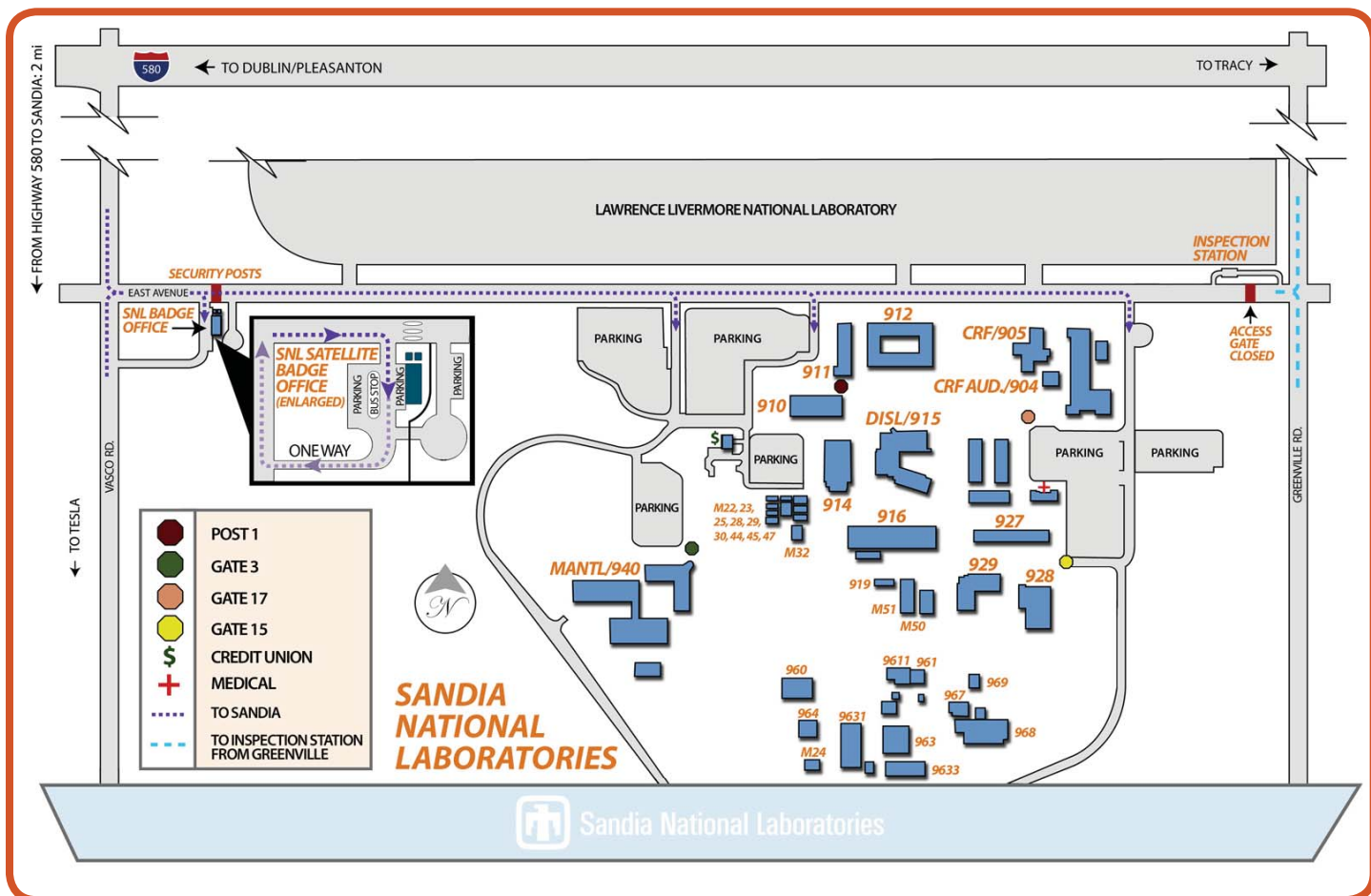


Visitor Map



From Interstate 580, take the Vasco South exit (#55). Continue south for 2 miles. Turn left onto East Avenue, making sure to turn into the right-hand lane. Then turn right almost immediately into the small parking lot. Park, enter Sandia's Badge Office (M53), and present your valid picture ID (driver's license or passport). Please note that no public restrooms are available in M53.

After receiving your visitor badge, exit the parking lot and turn right onto Vasco Road. Then turn right again at East Avenue. Stop at the East Avenue Security Post, and show your badge. You can now proceed to your destination.

Sandia/California does not offer public tours and generally limits site visits to those with an explicit business purpose. To obtain a visitor badge, your name must be on an "authorized for access" list, and you must present a picture ID (driver's license or passport).

Prohibited items:

- Intoxicants, illegal drugs, and paraphernalia
- Firearms, weapons, explosives, incendiary devices, or any other dangerous instruments or materials likely to produce injury or damage to persons or property
- Cellular telephones, radios, or other transmitting devices
- Electronic equipment with data ports capable of connection to automated information systems
- Computers
- Binoculars
- Recording equipment (audio, video, optical, data)

Applying for a visitor badge:

- Make arrangements with your Sandia point of contact at least 3 days (U.S. citizens) or 4–6 weeks (foreign nationals) before your visit. U.S. citizens must provide the following information: social security number, birth date, citizenship, home address and phone number, and business address and phone number. Because of additional access requirements, foreign nationals should make arrangements as early as possible.

Wearing your badge:

- You must wear your badge at all times while on-site at Sandia. Badges should be worn above the waist (prominently displayed) on your outer clothing. Your badge should not be worn off Sandia premises or used for personal identification.

Returning your visitor badge:

- Visitor badges must be returned to Sandia at the end of your visit. You can give your badge to your host or bring it to a Sandia badge office. Do **not** put your badge in the badge return boxes at the East Avenue Security Post.
