Purpose(s) The purpose of this system of records is to have Social Security Act

earnings information available to RRB benefit programs for

determinations related to RRA benefit entitlement and amount. The records are stored in the Employment Data Maintenance database.

Policies and Practices for Storing, Retrieving, Accessing, Retaining, and Disposing of Records in the System

Storage Mainframe computer database.

Retrievability Social security account number and name.

Safeguards Mainframe computer database; computer and computer storage

rooms are restricted to authorized personnel; on-line query safeguards include a lock/unlock password system; a terminal

oriented transaction matrix; and an audit trail.

Retention and Disposal Updates are made to database weekly using files transmitted to

RRB from SSA over telephone lines.
