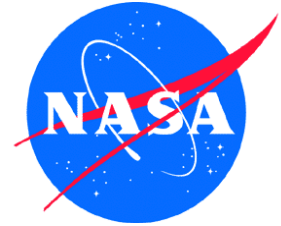

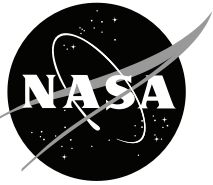

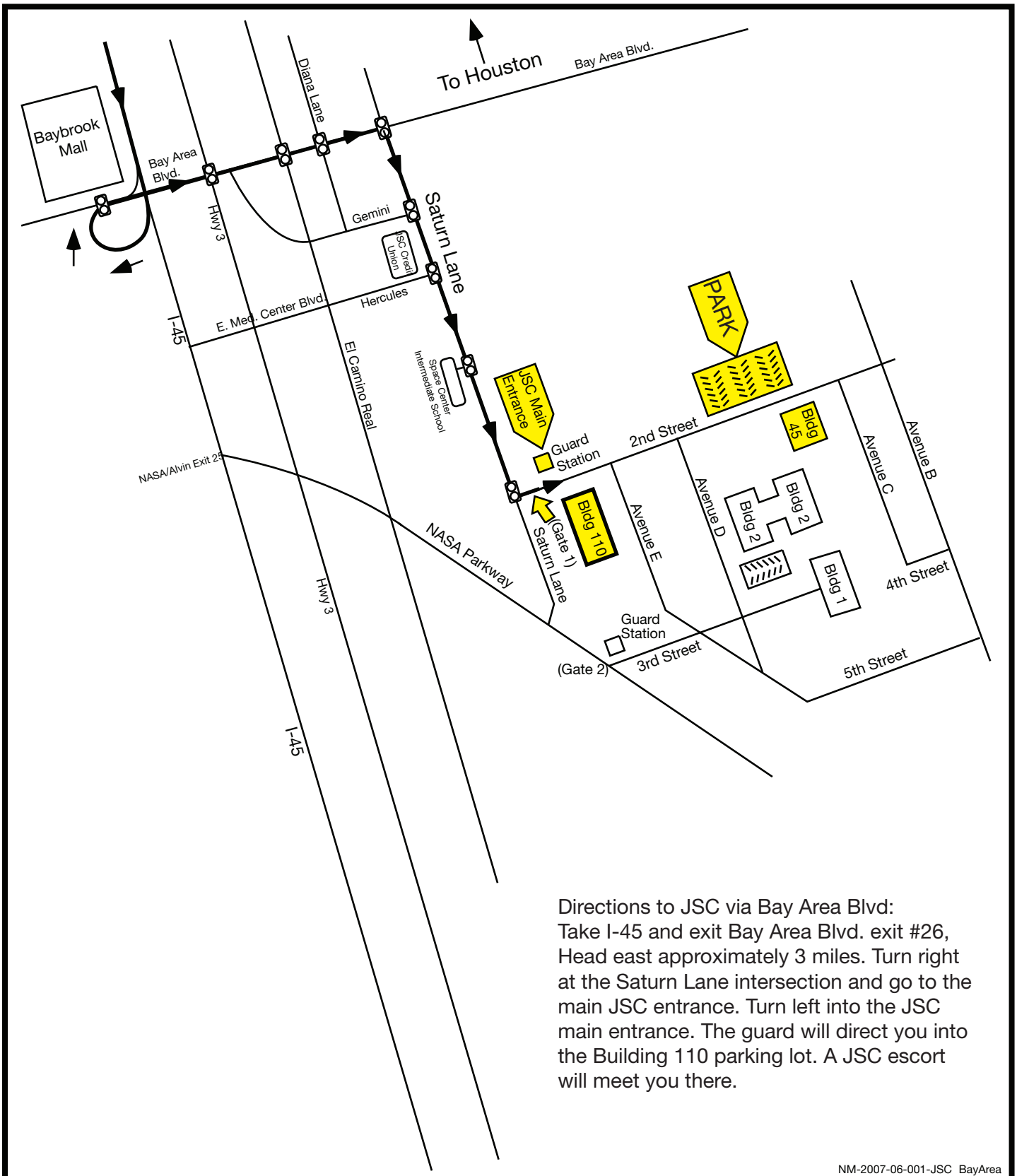
The Johnson Space Center (JSC) Technology Transfer Office looks forward to meeting with you. The following information should answer many of your questions regarding your arrival at JSC.

- You will arrive at Building 110, which is located at the main JSC entrance on Saturn Boulevard. Please plan to arrive 20-30 minutes prior to your meeting to pick up your entrance badge. You will then proceed to Building 45. The enclosed maps will help you as you travel to JSC.
- Please wear your badge at all times. Your JSC access is limited to the buildings authorized on your badge.
- It is important to observe all traffic and pedestrian rules. The posted speed limit is 25 miles per hour and you must stop for all pedestrians crossing in the designated cross walks.
- Use of cellular devices is not allowed while driving on JSC property.
- Please do not park in reserved spaces. These spaces have a name or number marker on the parking spot. You may park in unmarked spaces.

Take I-45 and exit Bay Area Blvd. exit #26,
Head east approximately 3 miles. Turn right
at the Saturn Lane intersection and go to the
main JSC entrance. Turn left into the JSC
main entrance. The guard will direct you into
the Building 110 parking lot. A JSC escort
will meet you there.
