EMPLOYER STATUS DETERMINATION CHATTANOOGA TERMINAL RAILWAY COMPANY

This is the decision of the Railroad Retirement Board regarding the status of the Chattanooga Terminal Railway Company (CTRC) as an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts. Service for CTRC has been creditable since 1935.

Effective August 1, 1993, CTRC was merged into its parent corporation, Alabama Great Southern Railway Company (AGS). AGS has been an employer under the Acts since November 11, 1977, and is indirectly a subsidiary of Norfolk Southern Corporation. Employees of both CTRC and AGS are reported under Norfolk Southern Corporation's B.A. number, 9408.

The Board holds that CTRC ceased to be an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts effective close of business August 1, 1993.
