EMPLOYER STATUS DETERMINATION Beaufort East Coast Railroad Company

This is the determination of the Railroad Retirement Board concerning the status of Beaufort East Coast Railroad Company (BECR) as an employer under the Railroad Retirement Act (45 U.S.C. §231 <u>et seq.</u>) (RRA) and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act (45 U.S.C. §351 <u>et seq.</u>) (RUIA).

According to a letter dated November 4, 1993, from A.T. Leary, Jr., President of Beaufort & Morehead Railway, Inc. (BMRI), BERC was dissolved and ceased to be a railroad on February 4, 1991, when BMRI purchased the assets of BERC and commenced operations. Employees of BERC became employees of BMRI.¹

Based upon the information summarized above, it is determined that Beaufort East Coast Railroad Company ceased to be a rail carrier employer under the RRA and RUIA effective February 4, 1991.
