Employer Status Determination Oregon, California & Eastern Railway Company

This is the decision of the Railroad Retirement Board regarding the status of the Oregon, California & Eastern Railway Company (OCER) as an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts.

The OCER was held to be an employer under the Acts effective October 6, 1915 (B.A. Number 2715). It ceased operations in November 1990 and paid severance payments in 1991. On November 13, 1991 the Interstate Commerce Commission granted an exemption to be effective December 25, 1991, from prior approval for cessation of operations.

Accordingly, the Board holds that OCER ceased to be an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts effective December 25, 1991.
