

**EMPLOYER STATUS DETERMINATION  
ANN ARBOR RAILROAD COMPANY**

This is the decision of the Railroad Retirement Board regarding the status of the Ann Arbor Railroad Company as an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts.

The Ann Arbor Railroad Company was held to be an employer under the Acts effective September 21, 1895. It ceased operations March 31, 1976. Ann Arbor became bankrupt in the mid-1970's and the estate was closed on April 4, 1984. It appears that the employees of Ann Arbor became employees of Conrail as of March 31, 1976. Ann Arbor has had no employees since March 31, 1976.

Accordingly, the Board holds that the Ann Arbor Railroad Company ceased to be an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts effective close of business April 4, 1984.
