EMPLOYER STATUS DETERMINATION AKRON & BARBERTON BELT RAILROAD COMPANY

This is the decision of the Railroad Retirement Board regarding the status of the Akron & Barberton Belt Railroad Company (A&BB) as an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts.

The A&BB was held to be an employer under the Acts effective May 6, 1902. It ceased operations July 20, 1994. A&BB last compensated employees on that same date. All of A&BB's rail assets were sold to the Akron Barberton Cluster Railway Company, an employer under the Acts.

Accordingly, the Board holds that the Akron & Barberton Belt Railroad Company ceased to be an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts effective close of business July 20, 1994.
