

The award-winning projects fall into three categories; Apprenticeship opportunities, Alternative Education and Expansion projects that competed successfully to expand their operations. Apprenticeship opportunities will prepare young adult offenders for in-demand careers in fields such as construction, welding, masonry and advanced manufacturing. Programs geared toward alternative education will create or enhance schools to help young offenders earn diplomas and continue on to postsecondary education or jobs. Expansion projects that have demonstrated success with juvenile offenders will be empowered to open two additional sites.
