**JOINT MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER
RELATING TO THE EXCHANGE OF DESIGNATED TESTIMONY, OBJECTIONS
TO DESIGNATED TESTIMONY, COUNTERDESIGNATIONS, AND OBJECTIONS
TO COUNTERDESIGNATIONS**

Complaint Counsel and Respondent Union Oil Company of California stipulate to and jointly request that Your Honor modify the Revised Scheduling Order with regard to the dates for the exchange of designated testimony, objections to designated testimony, counterdesignations, and objections to counterdesignations. Under the Revised Scheduling Order issued on September 9, 2004, objections and counterdesignations are scheduled to be exchanged on Friday, October 1, 2004.

The parties have been working together to try to streamline the adjudicative hearing in this matter. As a result, they have agreed to designate portions of the deposition testimony of several additional witnesses from the witness lists rather than calling those witnesses live at trial. In order to minimize the amount of testimony that is designated, the parties agree that they should take the time to make selective designations and counterdesignations. They have therefore stipulated to and jointly request that Your Honor amend the Revised Scheduling Order to grant the following extensions:


