**ORDER MODIFYING SCHEDULING ORDER**

Complaint Counsel and Respondent NTSP on February 11, 2004, jointly filed a motion to modifying the Scheduling Order previously issued by the Court. The motion is GRANTED, and the Scheduling Order is modified as set forth below.

- March 6, 2004 - Deadline for depositions of experts (including rebuttal experts).
- March 9, 2004 - Deadline for filing motions for summary decision.
- March 9, 2004 - Complaint Counsel provides to Respondent's Counsel its final proposed witness and exhibit lists, including designated testimony to be presented by deposition, copies of all exhibits (except for demonstrative, illustrative or summary exhibits), and a brief summary of the testimony of each witness.
- Complaint Counsel serves courtesy copies on ALJ of its final proposed witness and exhibit lists and a brief summary of the testimony of each witness.
- March 16, 2004 - Respondent's Counsel provides to Complaint Counsel its final proposed witness and exhibit lists, including designated testimony to be presented by deposition, copies of all exhibits (except for demonstrative, illustrative or summary exhibits), and a brief summary of the testimony of each witness.
- Respondent's Counsel serves courtesy copies on ALJ of its final proposed witness and exhibit lists and a brief summary of the testimony of each witness.

March 16, 2004 - Parties that intend to offer into evidence at the hearing confidential materials of an opposing party or non-party must provide notice to the opposing party or non-party pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 3.45(b).

March 26, 2004 - Deadline for filing responses to motions for summary decision.
