This letter briefly summarizes the lengthy conversation you, David Burse and I engaged in Monday afternoon in a good faith effort to narrow the scope of many requests for production and to address related issues concerning the subpoena duces tecum directed to our client, Mitsubishi Electric & Electronics USA, Inc. ("MEUS") by your client, Rambus, Incorporated ("Rambus") in the above matter. We began by discussing the fact that MEUS is a separate entity from Mitsubishi Electric Corp. ("MELCO"), a Japanese company. We also discussed MEUS's concerns regarding the production burden imposed by the requests as propounded and regarding requests calling for documents that are privileged and/or contain confidential and commercially sensitive information.

We then discussed each of the 63 requests for production in the subpoena. Of particular note, we agreed as follows: (1) Rambus has withdrawn Requests 21 and 32; (2) you will send me a copy of page 4 of the December 1991 JEDEC meeting minutes referenced in Request 13, which was not attached as an exhibit to the subpoena; (3) you will send me a copy of the "Rambus NDA" defined in Request 1 and further referenced in Requests 2-8 (an agreement which Rambus apparently entered into with MELCO rather than MEUS); and (4) David and I will address various proposals related to other requests for production with MEUS and contact you on Friday at 10:00 a.m. to discuss these issues further.
