A Common Source of *Salmonella*



- Pet turtles may look cute and harmless, but they can make you very sick!
- Turtles carry a type of bacteria called *Salmonella* on their outer skin and shell. *Salmonella* can cause serious or even life-threatening infection in people and can be caused by contact with turtles in petting zoos, parks, child day care facilities, or other locations.
