POPULATION SERVED/RECRUITMENT: The Project will serve 45 participants over a two year period of performance concluding March 31, 2010. Participants will be identified and referred to the Family Fathering Reentry Court Program (FCR) by Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency and the Federal Bureau of Prisons. The FCR will conduct interviews and assessments of all referred potential participants.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The Healthy Families/Thriving Communities Collaborative Council Incorporated will complete intake and assessments to identify employment, social services, and treatments needs of the participant. A case management plan will be developed and implemented. The plan will include referrals to all of the services the participant need in order to achieve long term employment. Throughout the course of the implementation the case manager will verify, by random visits, no less the fifty percent of the participants scheduled appointments to service providers.
