The **FDA Office of Women's Health** invites you to collaborate with them on a campaign called **Take Time To Care** (TTTC) that provides women and their families with free health information. Take Time to Care was launched in 1998. The goal of the campaign is to disseminate FDA health materials to women through outreach with community groups, religious institutions, national organizations, and industry. The FDA Office of Women's Health provides its collaborators with free health fact sheets and brochures that they in turn distribute to women across the country. To date, over 30 million consumers have been reached with TTTC materials that were disseminated at urban, rural, and reservation sites in the US, Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands.

In the beginning, **Take Time to Care** focused on safe medication use. Over the years, the program has expanded to provide easy-to-read information on a variety of topics including diabetes, mammography, smoking cessation, heart disease, HIV, and cosmetics. Currently, we have over 50 publications including materials available in Spanish and ten Asian languages.
