National Agricultural Workers Survey FINDINGS: 1989-2004

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What is the NAWS?

- The NAWS, an establishment-based survey, is the only national information source on the demographic, employment, and health characteristics of hired crop workers. There are an estimated 1.7 million hired crop workers in the U.S.
- The survey was created in response to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986 (IRCA). It was designed to determine if a shortage of seasonal agricultural workers was to be expected annually from 1990 to 1993. H-2A workers are not included in the NAWS.
- The data are used to monitor the supply side of the farm labor market and to estimate the number of farm workers and their dependents who are eligible for federal programs.









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Demographic Characteristics

 42,821 hired crop workers were interviewed in fiscal years 1989-2004




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Birthplace of NAWS Respondents

■ U.S.-born ■ Foreign-born












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Legal Status of NAWS Respondents
