1. Is an onsite PM required, or can the offeror propose an internal PM, if our office is located in the metro DC area?
 - a. Pursuant to Section C.1.5.1.3 – Project Manager, of the Performance Work Statement, the Service Provider (SP) shall identify to the CO in writing an on-site project manager (PM) in Washington, DC to be available during normal operating hours, who will be the primary point of contact to address and/or resolve contract or technical issues. The PM (or designated acting PM) shall be available for discussion with the Federal Project Officer (FPO) during normal business hours, usually between 8:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time (EST). The SP shall designate an alternate to function in the absence of the primary PM. The name of the PM shall be included in the SP's proposal or the position description of this person will be provided. The PM shall be the primary point through which (and/or shall maintain close oversight of) communications, work assignments, and technical direction flowing between the Government and the SP. The CO shall be the SP's first Point of Contact (POC) in the Government.

2. In Section C.1.1, it states that this is a task and sub-task driven contract, yet in other locations, such as B.3, "Schedule of Prices," it is listed as a FFP. Please clarify the nature of the tasks and subtasks anticipated in this effort.
 - a. Pursuant to Section C.1.1 Introduction of the PWS, the objective of this performance work statement (PWS) is to describe the performance objectives for the Program Support Services (PSS) functions for the Department of Labor (DOL) at multiple DOL Agencies (identified in Table C.1.1). DOL Agencies are located at sites throughout the United States and its territories. All functions and activities will be task and sub-task driven, and all work performed must be in accordance with the PWS, Solicitation and as instructed by the designated Government representative(s). The functions and activities are task and sub-task driven. As stated in Section B of the RFP, the Government intends to award a firm-fixed-priced type contract.
