Laboratories for the 21st Century (Labs21) is now accepting applications from experts in the field of sustainable laboratory design to become registered instructors for the following Labs21 courses:

- Labs21 Introductory Course: High Performance, Low-Energy Design
- Labs21 Advanced Course: Laboratory Ventilation Design
- Labs21 Workshop: Environmental Performance Criteria
- Labs21 Workshop: Operations and Maintenance

Labs21 has established a course steering committee and intends to identify and utilize 36 instructors—3 engineers and 3 architects from each of the following U.S. regions: Northeast, Southeast, North Central, South Central, Northwest, and Southwest.

The Labs21 Course Steering Committee, chaired by Labs21 co-sponsors the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and U.S. Department of Energy, will approve qualified individuals. Instructors will be registered through the Labs21 network and will be asked to teach one or more workshops within their region each year.

Individuals interested in becoming a Registered Labs21 Instructor must:

- 1) Hold state architecture or engineering licenses and registrations.
- 2) Participate in an interview with a representative of the Labs21 Course Steering Committee.
- 3) Audit at least one course taught by the current Labs21 Technical Team.
- 4) Teach a course with one of the Labs21 Team members.
- 5) Receive a satisfactory evaluation for teaching performance by that Team member.
