This letter responds to the January 26, 2005, Divestiture Petition ("Petition") of Enterprise Products Partners L.P. ("Enterprise") and Dan L. Duncan requesting that the Commission approve Enterprise's sale of the Starfish Pipeline Interest to MarkWest Energy Partners, L.P. ("MarkWest"), pursuant to the order in this matter. The application was placed on the public record for comments for thirty days, until March 1, 2005, and no comments were received.

After consideration of the proposed transaction as set forth in the Petition and supplemental documents, as well as other available information, the Commission has determined to approve the divestiture of the Starfish Pipeline Interest to MarkWest.
